

General French (FG)

This course is designed for adults of different nationalities who wish to improve their French communication skills for personal or professional reasons. Students are taught in small groups by qualified teachers, who create a friendly and dynamic learning environment.



FG objectives:

- Obtain fluency and the confidence to communicate in French in everyday situations
- Discovering French culture and society in different ways
- Develop your know-how and social skills in an international environment and in situations of communication

TEACHERS	Our teachers have a degree in teaching French as a Foreign Language (FLE) and receive ongoing training to develop their teaching techniques. They animate alternately the course and coordinate with each other for a precise follow-up according to the objectives of the CEFR grid.		
FG GROUP PLACEMENT	On official starting dates, each new student will do a written and oral evaluation in order to organize the FG groups.		
CERTIFICATE	Each participant receives, on the day of their departure, a certificate indicating the duration and the level of the taken course based on the Common European Framework of Reference (CEFR).
