MONDAY: City Orientation

13h00

Join us for a brief City Orientation. Your guide will take you around the City to show you some important places and explain to you how to get around.

Today we offer a free transfer to explore Cape Town's most iconic landmark. Hike up or take the cable car and have something to eat at the top, explore the mountain or just relax while you take in the beautiful panoramic view of the city.

## WEDNESDAY: Groot Constantia Wine Experience

Today we visit the oldest wine farm in South Africa, Groot Constantia. Go on a cellar tour and taste some of the award-winning wines produced here.

#### THURSDAY to SUNDAY: 4 Day Garden Route and Safari

#### Thursday

Depart Cape Town and drive down the longest wine route in the world, Route 62 towards Oudtshoorn where we'll stay tonight with a delicious ostrich steak braai (BBQ) for dinner.

#### Friday

After breakfast we head to the World famous Cango Caves. We'll join a guided adventure or standard tour through the magnificent twisting and turning cave system of the Swartberg. In the afternoon we'll do some canoeing in Wilderness before we reach our overnight destination in Sedgefield.

#### Saturday

Enjoy breakfast at a local farmers market before we follow the road through SA's favourite town, Knysna on route to Bloukrans Bungy jump and the Tsitsikamma area. We visit the beautiful Tsitsikamma National Park where we go for a walk in the forest.

#### Sunday

After breakfast we head for the Garden Route Game Lodge for a 2.5 hour safari to enjoy the African bush. After lunch we will make our way back to Cape Town with arrival early evening.

## TUESDAY: Bo-Kaap Walking Tour

In the heart of Cape Town City the Bo-Kaap or the Malay Quarter, captures the spirit and culture of a community known as the Cape Malays. The Cape Malays, or Cape Muslim community, has largely contributed to the making of the City's cultural melting pot.

# WEDNESDAY: Cecilia Forest to Kirstenbosch Hike
