





POWER SPEAKING

Power Speaking is an intense and challenging program that focuses on helping students increase their confidence and English public speaking abilities, as well as building, developing, and using new vocabulary Each study block focuses on one type of speech (Persuasive, Informative and Demonstrative) in which new speaking skills and vocabulary are introduced and practiced.

For part of the day, students participate in an extended facilitated discussion, followed by a class-wide debrief. Students receive constant grammar and pronunciation error correction with verbal and written feedback from the instructor.
