Mountain and coast | *Culture and tradition*



Granada is situated in the south east of Andalusia and has a population of 280.000. It is an ideal site for winter sports, being 36 km away from the winter resort of Sierra Nevada whose sports facilities are one of the most attractive of Europe.

Furthermore, it is only 70 km away from the Costa Tropical: **beaches and good weather just nearby!**

Granada, the Moorish city. It was the last kingdom to be reconquered by the Christians from the Moors. Its Moorishness is evident throughout the town, but especially in the Alhambra Palace and Generalife, one of the most visited monuments in the world. On the opposite hill you will find the Albaicin, the ancient moorish quarter with its narrow cobbled lanes and squares and traditional houses.

A place for Flamenco, centred on the district of Sacromonte, inhabited by gypsies who have become singers, dancers and guitarists. They have spread their art throughout the world.



The University and its atmosphere, with one of the oldest Universities in Spain (over 500 years old) where you can study almost any of the public degree options. At the moment, it has around 60.000 students.

A cultural town. Apart from **Semana Santa** (Easter) and **Fiestas del Corpus**, other events stand out: a **Jazz Festival** (autumn), **The International Festival of Theatre** (spring) and the **International Festival of Music and Dance** (spring). As well as these events theatrical representations, concerts and flamenco shows, etc., occur throughout the year at the Manuel de Falla cultural center, the Palacio de Congresos and in various other centers created for these purposes.

Your Spanish language school in the centre of Granada

It was established in 1992 in the beautiful city of the Alhambra, which is considered one of the wonders of the world. The geographical location of Granada is privileged, 30 minutes from Sierra Nevada Natural Park and ski resort, and 1 hour from the Costa Tropical.

The school is located in the heart of the city, in the unique quarter of El Realejo, less than a five minute walk from Puerta Real, the Cathedral, Gran Vía de Colón, theaters, hotels, restaurants, shops, etc. In short, in our center of Granada you can learn the Spanish language 'one step' the hub of life in Granada, surrounded by all the facilities and amenities.

iNMSOL Granada (Accredited Center of the Instituto Cervantes) has five classrooms fully-equipped for the study of Spanish with TV, video, DVD and audio CD. All this together with the reduced number of students per class (maximum 10 students), creates an atmosphere and a very friendly and personalized service that makes learning the Spanish language very natural.



GENERAL INFORMATION ABOUT THE COURSES

Classes taught in Spanish from the first day, at all levels



- iMSOL courses start every Monday for all levels.
- Each Spanish class lasts 45 minutes. Each flamenco class lasts 60 minutes.
- Classes are held Monday through Friday (except holidays).
- The class schedule can be morning or afternoon.
- The maximum number of students per class is 10 participants.
- Before starting the course there will be a language test to determine the participant's level of Spanish.
- The course will receive a certificate of attendance upon completion. To do this you must have attended at least 85% of classes.

Legal information about Private Schools "Not regulated teaching Agreement":

As all the private schools whose rules aren't imposed by the government, Instituto Mediterráneo Sol has its own certificates (attendance and aptitude), that means that they neither are issued nor recognised by any official organization. Instituto Mediterráneo Sol is a centre not owned by Consejería de Educación and Ciencia de la Junta de Andalucía or any other public organization. Even so: The levels in our Attendance and Aptitude Certificates, as the course programme and the general and specific goals per level that we want to achieve through the same, fit the European Common Reference Framework for Languages and the Curricula Plan of Instituto Cervantes.

METHODOLOGY

Developing a direct, situational and communicative method

- ✍ Teaching is carried out entirely in Spanish and without using any other language support.
- ✍ Vocabulary and Grammar are studied in a contextual way, placing particular emphasis on the students' participation both in the oral and in the written production.
- ✍ Exercises on the different grammatical structures, dictations and readings, paying special attention on the phonetics and pronunciation, and encouraging free or directed conversation, always with the teacher's corrections.
- ✍ Before starting the lessons participants will have to do a language test. As the classes are structured in blocks depending on the number of lessons of the course, one more grammatical and the other more of oral production, there exists the possibility of differentiating the levels between both parts, therefore participants could join two different group depending on their levels of grammar and conversation and vocabulary.
- ✍ Groups will be officially set on Tuesday.

OUR INTENSIVE COURSES

All the skills are covered: listening, reading, speaking and writing

Our Intensive Spanish courses cover the four language skills: *listening, oral expression and interaction, reading comprehension and written expression and interaction.*

Teaching is carried out entirely in Spanish and without using any other language support, developing a direct, situational and communicative method, seeking mental association between the object and the concept of the word or corresponding words in Spanish. The Intensive Spanish courses have a minimum duration of 4 lessons per day, and can be modified up to 6 lessons per day, or combined with individual tuition, you chose!

These courses are available throughout the year, starting any Monday (except holidays), so that the student can choose the start date that suits you.



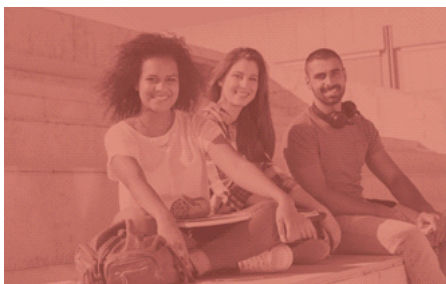
PREPARATORY COURSES FOR **DELE** and **SIELE** EXAMS

Issued by the Instituto Cervantes

The Diplomas of Spanish as a Foreign Language (**DELE**) are official qualifications accrediting levels of competence and command of the Spanish language, granted by the Instituto Cervantes on behalf of the Ministry of Education and Science of Spain. There are six levels: A1, A2, B1, B2, C1 and C2. iNMSOL offers a preparatory course for the DELE, programmed to familiarize participants with these tests: consists of 4 classes each day specifically centered on the 5 tests exam: listening, speaking, reading comprehension, use of language and writing.

It is necessary that participants have approximately the level of the exam they wish to do. Otherwise, iNMSOL will inform about the best option for them. The price does not include examination fees, but we can take care of your registration and give you all information on schedules, testing place, etc. since we are FEDELE organizer center in this city. Levels: A1, A2, B1, B2, C1, C2. Start dates: every Monday of the year. Minimum duration: 1 week.

SIELE is the International Service for the Evaluation of the Spanish Language that certifies the degree of command of Spanish through electronic means. Candidates will be able to book and take their exam in iNMSOL with full flexibility of dates.



COURSES FOR SENIORS 50+

For students aged 50+

This course is drawn up for people aged 50+ who want to learn or improve their Spanish. It has 2 classes a day. The class pace is much more relaxed and much more communicative and adapted to the real needs of this target.

Levels: all. Start dates: every Monday of the year. Minimum duration: 1 week.



COURSES FOR TEENAGERS

Aimed at students between 13 and 17 years old

Summer courses with specific start dates. They are offered in packages that include:

- **Spanish course**, 4 lessons / day for 2, 3 or 4 weeks.
- **Home-stay Accommodation**: full-board, double room. Arrival on Sunday before the start of the course, departure on Saturday just after the end of it. Different dates of arrival or departure will be informed to the school and charged.
- **Daily program of cultural and leisure activities**.
- **1, 2 or 3 excursions or teen activities**, depending the number of weeks.
- **Transfer Granada Airport - Accommodation + Accommodation - Granada Airport**.
- **AMONITOR**, whose tasks are:
 - Control of night-time arrival. This control is done in collaboration with families where students are housed. The monitor will be available by phone calls from families who want to communicate a delay student night.
 - Attending classes.
 - Assistance activities. Must attend all the scheduled specifically for adolescents.
 - It will be the reference point for all of them when they need something or have a problem, whether academic, with accommodation or staff.
 - This monitor will have 24 hour a mobile phone for urgent matters that, if there is a problem, have immediate assistance.
 - Periodically he will talk with each of the students during their stay although this is not required in order to closely monitor it. There will be an hour a day when teenagers have to come to school to meet him.



Upon completion of the course participants will receive a **Certificate of Attendance iNMSOL**. The students must have attended at least **85% of classes**. **Levels**: all. **Starting Dates**: every week from **June to July**. **Minimum stay**: 2 weeks.

TRAINING COURSES FOR ELE TEACHERS

Aimed at teachers of Spanish, or students who want to become teachers

The training of teachers of Spanish lasts two weeks with 20 lessons a week. This course is recognized by the European Commission as **Erasmus + Programme**, students may receive a scholarship to do so. You can choose between three options:

Option A

Teachers with an intermediate level of Spanish who want to learn grammar and consider the didactic overcome (high school / primary):

1st and 2nd lessons: S1*
3rd lesson: S3*
4th lesson: S4*
Minimum level: B1

Option B

Students interested in becoming teachers of Spanish as a Foreign Language, who need to increase their knowledge of the Spanish language and also need more experience of teaching methods.

1st lesson: S1*
2nd lesson: S2*
3rd lesson: S3*
4th lesson: S4*
Minimum level: B2

Option C

Spanish teachers who have a very advanced level of Spanish and therefore do not need any extra lessons on grammar: they will improve their range of teaching methods and their knowledge of Spanish culture and traditions.

1st and 2nd lessons: S2*
3rd lesson: S3*
4th lesson: S4*
Minimum level: C1

*Subjects

S1: Spanish grammar in group lessons, depending on level.
S2: Methodology of Spanish as a Foreign Language: techniques, resources, classroom management.
S3: General topics of Spanish culture (literature, history, traditions...)
S4: Conversation and round table about general affairs concerning Spain in which the teacher will act as supervisor.

Courses dates: every Monday of the year (except from bank holidays).



SOCIAL PROGRAMME

Cultural and leisure activities



In order to complete the immersion in the Spanish culture, apart from the course, the school organizes a daily program of cultural and leisure activities carried out by teachers with experience in them. These activities are held in the afternoons/evenings, although attendance is not mandatory for the students. Some examples are:

- **Cultural walks:** important quarters, historical centers, interesting routes, etc..
- **Visits:** The Alhambra, Royal Chapel, Park of Sciences, etc.
- **Social activities:** workshops in music, history, literature and current events and news; films; tapa's tour, international dinners, etc.

Weekends excursions outside Granada are also included in our programme: famous Andalusian cities as Seville or Cordoba, places as the Alpujarra granadina or the Costa Tropical, among others.

The Social Programme will change every week.

iNMSOL can also arrange accommodation, acting as intermediary, with the guarantee that it will be ready at your arrival. The average walking distance to the school is 20 minutes. Participants do not need to bring beddings but their own towels and product of "personal hygiene". It can be chosen among these possibilities:

Shared Apartment

The apartments are fully equipped. The rooms have bed, wardrobe, desk and chair. They have common areas like living room with TV and place to sit and eat; kitchen with stove, refrigerator and washing machine; bathroom equipped.

Half board (two meals: breakfast, lunch or dinner). Full board (three meals: breakfast, lunch and dinner). Washing of clothes per week is included. It is necessary that the registration specified allergies, if you smoke or not, and eating habits.

COURSES' CONDITIONS

Instituto Mediterráneo Sol



General conditions according to the number of participants in the courses

The maximum number of students per class of the same level and the same course characteristics is 10, and the minimum is 3. If this minimum is not reached, the following conditions will apply:

- 1 student or 2 students:** the participant will receive 50% of the contracted lessons as one-to-one lessons (1 teacher/1 student) or semi-private lessons (1 teacher/2 students), according to his/her level and needs. In no case should the student pay the difference in price.
- 3 students or more:** participants will receive 100% of the contracted lessons, in group.

Exceptions to the general conditions:

Different conditions will apply to the following courses:

- *DELE preparation courses (2 and 4 lessons per day).*
- *Themed courses and courses for specific purposes: Spanish and Latin American literature; Spanish and Latin American history; Spanish and Latin American culture; Spanish for business; medical Spanish and Spanish for tourism.*
- *Training courses for ELE teachers (native and non-native).*
- *Course for Seniors 50+.*

For the rest of the courses the general conditions will apply.

DELE PREPARATION COURSES

- **DELE preparation courses of 2 lessons per day:** the student will obtain the total number of contracted lessons, even if he is the only participant, regardless of his level.
- **DELE preparation courses of 4 classes a day:**

1 student or 2 students: the participant will receive 50% of the contracted lessons as one-to-one lessons (1 teacher/1 student) or semi-private lessons (1 teacher/2 students), according to his/her level and needs. In no case should the student pay the difference in price.

If there is a grammar or conversation course (2 lessons/day) in which the student could participate, they will be invited to join for the number of lessons that have been reduced from their DELE preparation course, in addition to the individual lessons.

If the student just want to attend the preparation course, he will be charged only the price of 2 lessons/day.

3 students or more: participants will receive 100% of the contracted lessons, in group.

THEMED COURSES AND COURSES FOR SPECIFIC PURPOSES

For the following courses:

- *Spanish and Latin American literature*
- *Spanish and Latin American history*
- *Spanish and Latin American culture*
- *Spanish for Business*
- *Medical Spanish*

The following conditions apply:

If the course has 2 lessons per day: the student will obtain the total contracted lessons, even if he/she is the only participant, regardless of his level.

If the course has 4 lessons or more per day:

1 student or 2 students: the participant **will receive 50% of the contracted lessons** as one-to-one lessons (1 teacher/1 student) or semi-private lessons (1 teacher/2 students), according to his/her level and needs. In no case should the student pay the difference in price.

If there is a grammar or conversation course (2 lessons/day) in which the student could participate, they will be invited to join for the number of lessons that have been reduced from their course, in addition to the individual lessons.

3 students or more: participants **will receive 100% of the contracted lessons**, in group.

TRAINING COURSES FOR ELE TEACHERS

- **Training courses for non-native ELE teachers:**

1 student or 2 students: the participant **will receive 50% of the contracted lessons** as one-to-one lessons (1 teacher/1 student) or semi-private lessons (1 teacher/2 students), according to his/her level and needs. In no case should the student pay the difference in price.

If there is a grammar or conversation course (2 lessons/day) in which the student could participate, they will be invited to join for the number of lessons that have been reduced from their course, in addition to the individual lessons.

3 students or more: participants **will receive 100% of the contracted lessons**, in group.

- **Training courses for native ELE teachers:**

1 student or 2 students: 6 week-courses will be reduced to 4 weeks. The superintensive summer courses (6 lessons per day) will become intensive courses (4 lessons per day)

3 students or more: participants will receive 100% of the contracted lessons in group, and no reduction in weeks will be applied.

COURSE FOR SENIORS 50+

The student will obtain the total number of contracted lessons, even if he/she is the only participant, regardless of the level. If there are no other 50+ participants, he/she will be offered to join a grammar course or a conversation course with students of different ages and compatible levels, if the school has that option available.

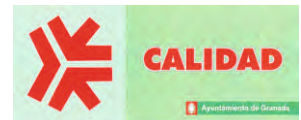
