


# Student arrivals and departures

The Bell experience starts from the moment we collect your child at the airport. A Bell representative with a Bell sign will meet your child in arrivals and travel to Bell with a member of staff. #### Example study tour: Natural History Museum, London

Project theme: Protecting the Planet

**Preparation task:** Review map of Natural History Museum, check vocabulary and language for asking directions. Discuss key questions to answer while at the Natural History Museum. **Study tour task:** Selfie scavenger hunt challenge. Find answers to the questions in the museum. Take a selfie with the answers to the questions.

Follow-up task: Students share their answers in the lesson following the study tour in a feedback session.

Your child will be fully supported throughout their experience at Bell.


We have a team of dedicated houseparents, teachers and activity leaders on site 24 hours a day, 7 days a week.

# Engaging project themes
