Supporting and inspiring young learners to achieve their potential is at the heart of everything we do.

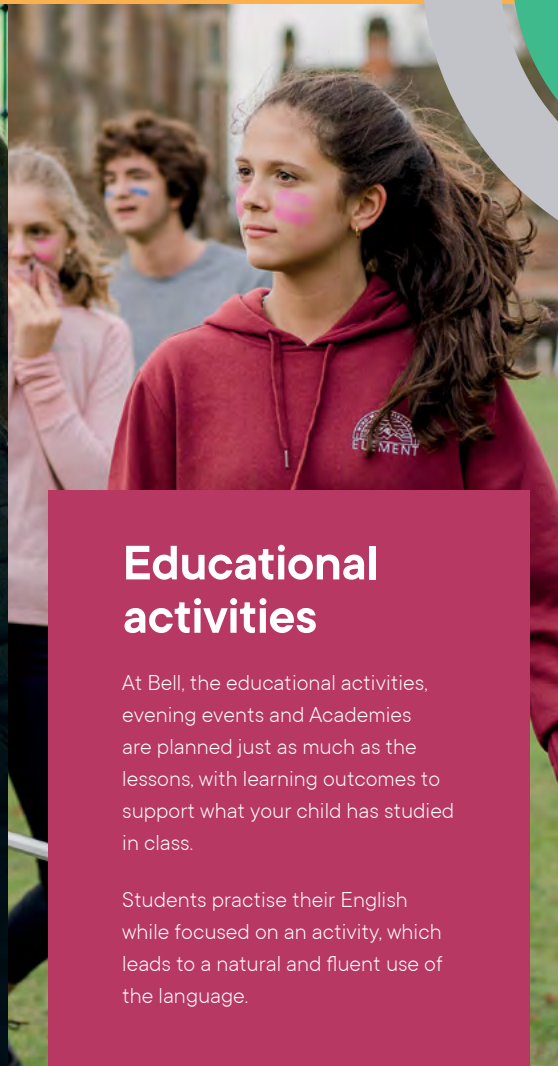
Lessons are carefully planned to improve students' language capabilities, develop vital 21st century life skills and build confidence.



Project-based learning

Student arrivals and departures

Language test

Study tours are important learning opportunities, which students prepare for during their lessons. Each study tour relates to the weekly project theme on our Explorer courses.

Example study tour: Natural History Museum, London

Project theme: Protecting the Planet

Preparation task: Review map of Natural History Museum, check vocabulary and language for asking directions. Discuss key questions to answer while at the Natural History Museum.

Study tour task: Selfie scavenger hunt challenge.

Find answers to the questions in the museum. Take a selfie with the answers to the questions.

Follow-up task: Students share their answers in the lesson following the study tour in a feedback session.

Your child will be fully supported throughout their experience at Bell.

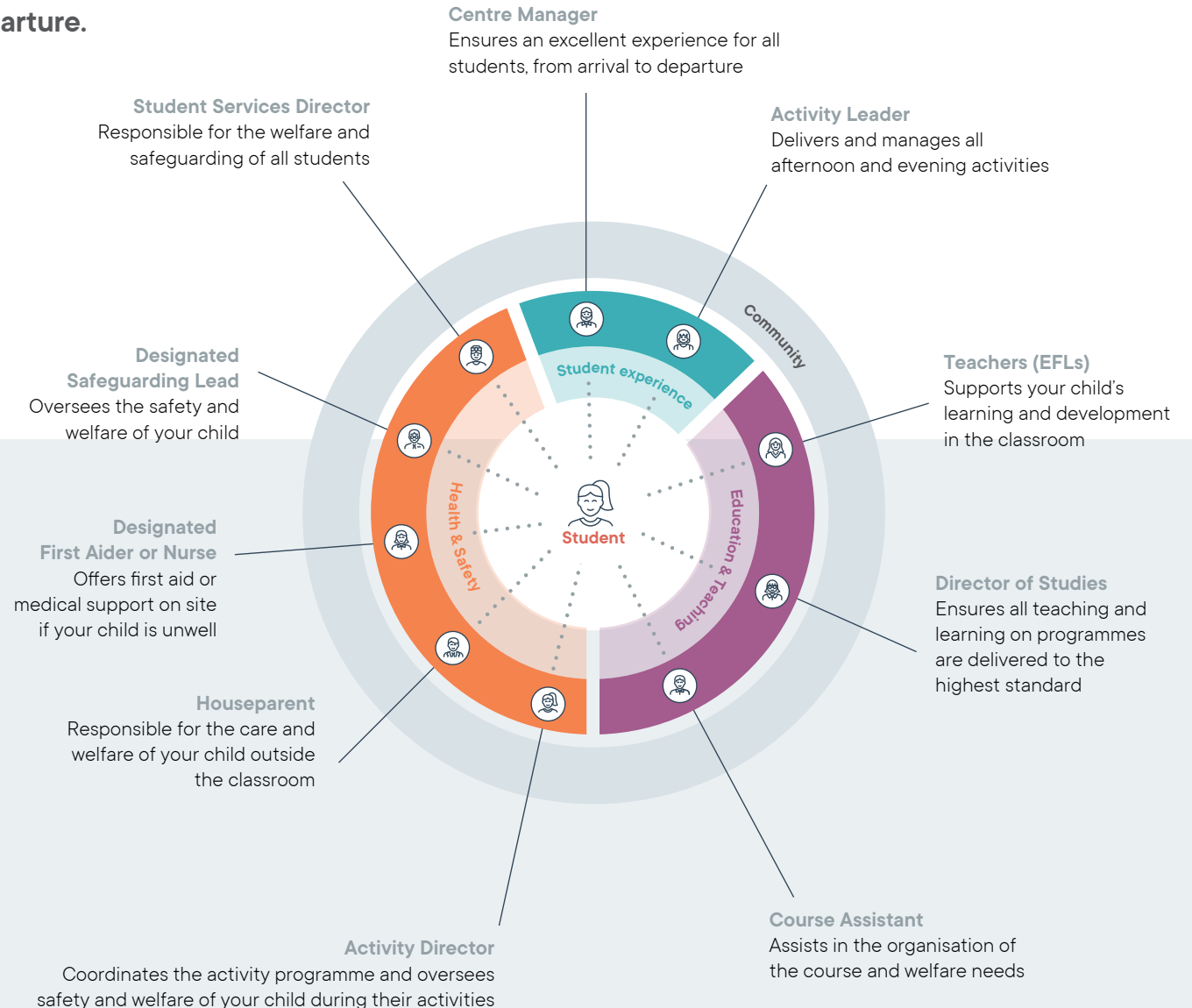
We have a team of dedicated houseparents, teachers and activity leaders on site 24 hours a day, 7 days a week.

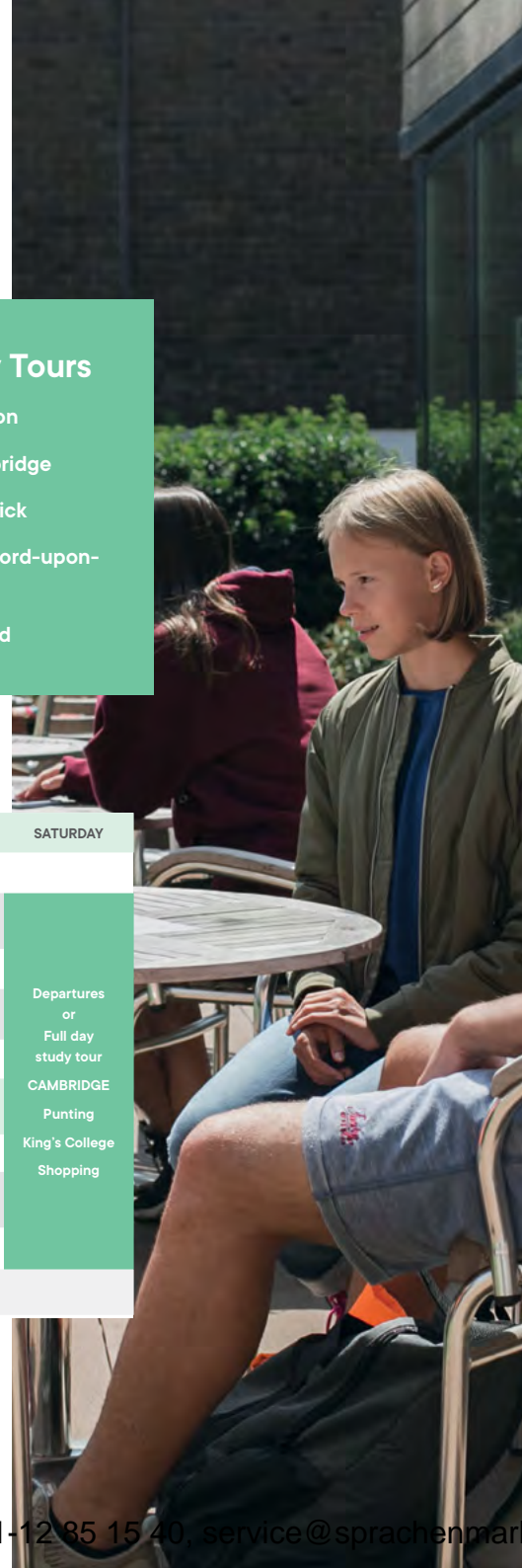

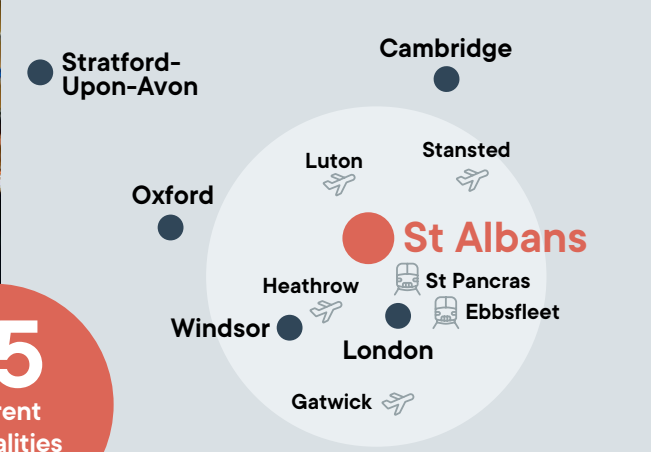

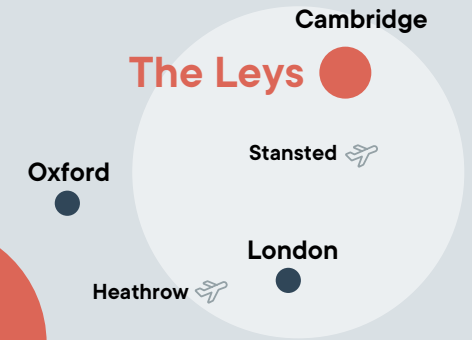
