Worldwide runs a lot of extra programmes which appeal to students who are interested in a unique and exciting experience beyond the classroom.

Many of these programmes need extra agency knowledge and extra enrolment requirements. For more details before making an application please contact the school.

PLUS International Flight Attendant/Travel & Tourism

In co-operation with Travel Careers and Training Ltd (http://www.travelcareers.co.nz ), a highly respected institute for travel & tourism and flight attendant courses, we are able to offer these special options

A high level of English is necessary for course and job success. Therefore, the minimum English level entry requirements are: IELTS 5.5 / TOEFL 500 / Cambridge FCE / OR level 5 (Upper-Intermediate) at Worldwide School. Students from Worldwide School will receive direct entry to TC&T based on our recommendation that the mimimum English level has been met.

PLUS Bar and Restaurant Management/Cookery

For students wishing to study Bar and Restaurant management and work in hospitality around the world and in NZ. In co-operation with a highly respected institute, we are able to offer this special options.

A high level of English is necessary for course and job success. Therefore, the minimum English level entry requirements are: IELTS 5.5 OR level 5 (Upper-Intermediate) at Worldwide School. Students from Worldwide School will receive direct entry based on our recommendation that the minimum English level has been met.

PLUS Working Holiday Visa Support Services

A number of countries have a Working Holiday Visa agreement with NZ (and more are added each year)

In 2013 these countries are:

Argentina, Belgium, Brazil, Chile, China, Czech Republic, Denmark, Estonia, Finland, France, Germany, Hong Kong, Italy, Japan, Korea, Malaysia, Mexico, Netherlands, Peru, Poland, Spain, Slovenia, Sweden, Taiwan, Thailand and Uruguay. Worldwide has a great support service for students from these countries to help them settle in NZ and find work.

PLUS Working Holiday Visa Support

\* Minimum enrolment period is 4 weeks full time. (6 weeks morning is also possible)

\* Meet with the WHV support co-ordinator to discuss options. The consultation will be held within 5 days of their start date. The discussion will be in English (but language counsellors may assist if there are difficulties with using English). The consultation must happen during the study period and not after the student graduates.

\* Get a bank account and a tax number

\* As part of the support students are taught how to put together a CV (Resume) in English and receive consultation on the type of jobs possible. Students need to bring any relevant information regarding their education and work experience with them (dates, companies/institutions, references).

\* Once the student has completed their English CV, the student will return for a second consultation to have their CV checked and be given assistance with job searching, using known local contacts, newspapers and the internet.

\* The student will learn interview techniques with WHV support co-ordinator.

\* The student will receive assistance to make phone calls and/or apply for jobs in writing along with the sending of CV's to potential employers.

\* The WHV support co-ordinator will also provide language support documents and discuss interview techniques and procedures for finding a job in New Zealand with the student.

\* The WHV support co-ordinator will be available by appointment to talk with the student about the WHV anytime during their course of study at school.

\* The student must be willing to accept any reasonable offer of employment. A "reasonable offer" is defined as a position meeting the student's qualifications within one of the following industries:

Fruitpicking, Factory Work, Labour Hire, Hospitality, Hotel, Promotional Work, Call Centre, Basic Administration, Retail, Tourism, Adventure / Outdoors. (minimum work period arranged is 2 weeks)

IMPORTANT: Please note we DO NOT find the job for the student. This they need to do for themself. However the "support" given helps them do this with little or no problems.

PLUS Internship. Satisfy your requirements by doing a volunteer internship experience with a company in Auckland.

Our Internship programme is operated on a case by case basis, which means that an applicant must first send an application to Worldwide school. This should include:

1/ Sector they wish to do an Internship. They should include more than one Internship possibility.

2/ CV of applicant - including previous work experience and study.

3/ Time of year they would like to come and length of English study and Internship.

Once we have accepted the applicant at Worldwide School:

4/References from the applicant's University, school or employer should be sent. In business and professional positions, it is necessary the student have at least one reference from an employer, including what they did during the job or internship.

It is necessary for the host company to interview the student before a placement is confirmed. This is as much for the student as for the company because it is a chance for them to see if the project and placement is suitable for them.

It is very important that our internship applicant's understand that the Host Company will ask them to complete tasks not directly related to their degree. For example; a marketing graduate with typing skills may do some data entry for their company as well as assisting and observing an advertising campaign. It is quite a large commitment for companies to accept a student because they take up time of at least one staff member, and if the Intern is taking some of the workload, the programme benefits the company as well as the Intern.

As each student's application is individually assessed, an area not included with the placement possibilities list may still be possible. The exception is Medicine. Under New Zealand law Internships in medicine are not allowed.

PLUS Au Pair. Only for female students with a working holiday visa, live with a family and help with daily life. Receive a small salary as well as free food and accommodation.

PLUS Environmental Volunteer. Our EV programme is an excellent and rewarding opportunity for people who would like to experience New Zealand's natural beauty while helping to preserve it.

- Be prepared to live in beautiful but basic surroundings
- Help our Department of Conservation to protect and preserve New Zealand's natural beauty and historic heritage for all to enjoy now and in the future

• Student will be placed in a North Island location quite far from cities, in amongst some of New Zealand's famous beautiful scenery

In order to enter the EV programme students must have at least an Intermediate level of English (level 4).

PLUS Farm Holiday or Experience. Choose to either have a holiday on a NZ farm or live on a farm and help the farmer.

Farm experience follows a 4 week minimum English course at Worldwide. At the farm students must work in return for food and accommodation.

2 weeks is the maximum farm placement.

Students need a minimum English level of Intermediate (level 4). If not we cannot guarantee a farm placement after arrival.

Farm holiday follows a 1 week minimum English course at Worldwide. At the farm students have a 1 week holiday with all included.

After the English course with us or during your holidays Worldwide School will arrange your farm experience or farm holiday.
