6 GENERAL ENGLISH COURSES

ALL COURSES:

Monday to Friday Morning: 9.00 am - 12.15 pm
Morning courses emphasise reading, writing, listening, speaking, vocabulary, grammar, pronunciation and a lot of communication practice.

Monday to Thursday Afternoon: 1.30 pm - 3.30 pm
The afternoon General English programme focuses on improving students listening skills and spoken fluency.

Business English is a General English Afternoon Option for higher level students who usually take it as part of a full-time intensive class. The fees are the same as Intensive English full time.
We prefer students take the whole class but less is possible.
Our Business English course follows the BEC Vantage curriculum.

9 CAMBRIDGE EXAM (UPPER LEVELS) 9, 10, 11, 12 WEEKS

10 TESOL + TKT + INTERNSHIP 5 WEEKS

This course is for students who are interested in becoming teachers of English. It is a 5-week intensive course (26 hours per week) in which students learn about TESOL and also prepare for the internationally recognised University of Cambridge TKT exam.

12 TOEIC (MIDDLE LEVELS) 5 WEEKS

Worldwide School is a TOEIC testing centre so students can take the TOEIC test at Worldwide. Students also need to pay extra for the TOEIC textbook and test.

Classes run from Monday to Thursday: 1.30 pm - 3.30 pm

Students are also encouraged to sign up for practice tests on Friday 1.30 pm - 3.30 pm.
3 courses per year, multiple exam dates available.

Course Dates:
11 March - 12 April (5 weeks) 23 September - 25 October (5 weeks)
24 June - 26 July (5 weeks)

Students wishing to do TOEIC preparation outside these dates can choose the Self-Access option and study in the Library.

11 IELTS (MIDDLE & UPPER LEVELS) 4 + WEEKS

We run 3 levels of IELTS classes: IELTS 3, IELTS 4 and IELTS 5.

IELTS 3 and IELTS 4 are for students who are at an intermediate level but are interested in a more academic English focus and possibly doing the IELTS exam in the future.

IELTS 5 is for students requiring an IELTS score of 5.0 to 6.5 or more and need to take the exam at the end of the course.

Classes run from Monday to Friday: 9am - 3.30pm (with a practice exam every Friday afternoon).

Students can join IELTS classes any Monday.
Students must study full-time.

Text books.

Class sets are provided free of charge for all IELTS students.
Tuition fees are the same as General English fees.

13 COMBO PROGRAMME 4 WEEKS MINIMUM

For students who want to divide their study time around New Zealand. Choose between three different schools, in three different cities: Worldwide School of English, New Horizon College of English and LSNZ Queenstown.

Study for a minimum of 2 weeks each at two or three schools.
Travel in between - book 12 weeks full-time or more and receive free transfers - the choice is yours.
