- materials, including course file, handouts, city map, information on Norwich
- end-of course certification and validation of Europass (where applicable)

- course-specific digital learning platform with six months extended access
- free wifi and computer access
- student welfare services
- social programme – comprising evening activities and a weekend excursion to a place of interest e.g. Cambridge or the Norfolk Coast

Accommodation in Norwich

Homestay accommodation is provided in single study-bedrooms with carefully selected hosts. It comprises bed, breakfast & evening meal each day and light lunch (or packed lunch as appropriate) at weekends.

Residential accommodation is provided on the campus of the University of East Anglia in single study-bedrooms with private bathroom. The accommodation is on a self-catering basis in university 'houses' or 'flats' with a shared kitchen/dining room, fully equipped for self-catering.
