

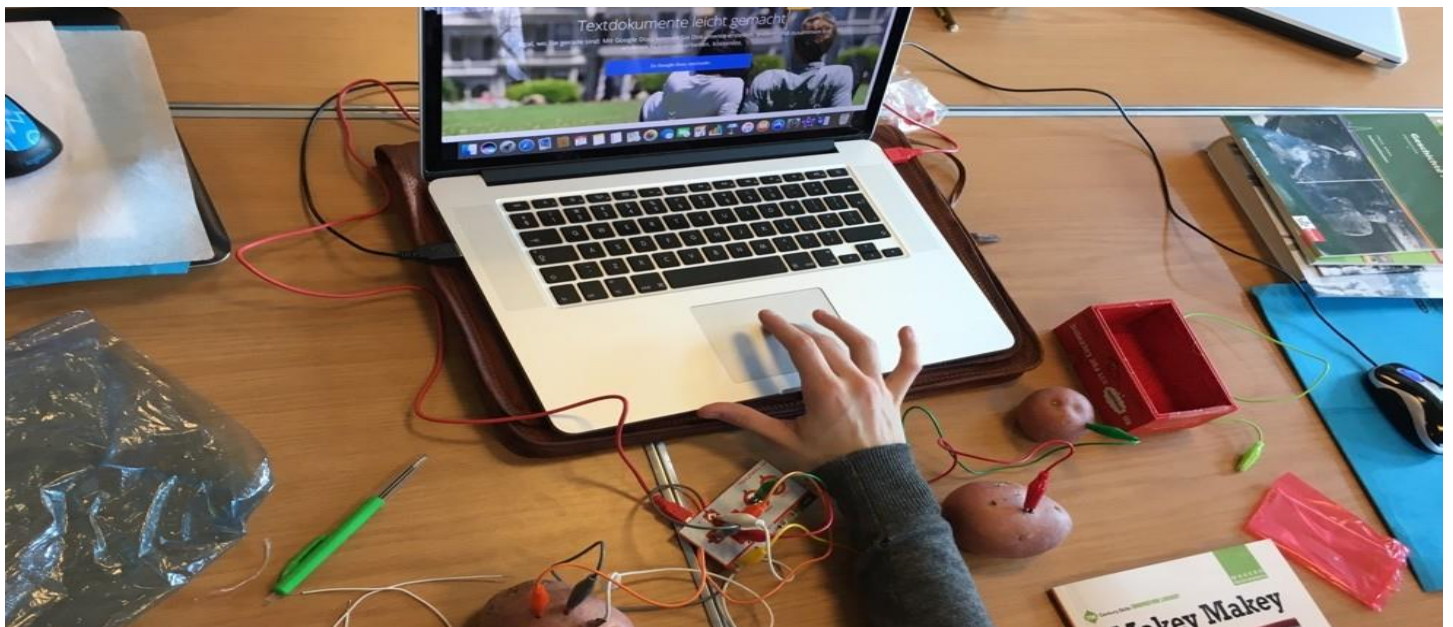
## EFFECTIVE TEACHING WITH DIGITAL TECHNOLOGY

1 & 2 WEEK COURSES FOR EUROPEAN TEACHERS  
in England and Wales and Ireland 2021

### COURSE OBJECTIVES:

Teachers of all subjects are invited to attend this course. You will have opportunities

- to reflect on and identify areas for development in your own digital literacies and skills
- to discover the potential for learning and teaching using digital technology, as well as the possible challenges
- develop your critical awareness as well as practical skills in using digital technologies
- to access dynamic online professional development resources, and develop an action plan for you to follow when you get home



### COURSE CONTENT:

#### 1. Workshops on Effective Teaching with Digital Technology

- exploring and assessing 21<sup>st</sup> century skills and digital literacies
- ideas for making lessons more stimulating and for motivating learners through activities which use technology creatively
- using web 2.0 tools creatively for in and out of class projects & homework
- exploiting and creating video and audio for learning (e.g. podcasts & vodcasts)
- creating and evaluating on-line quizzes
- how and why to use learner-generated multimedia content to enhance learning
- evaluation of digital tools
- flipped and blended learning
- digital storytelling for effective learning
- task design for more motivating lessons
- micro-teaching and explaining concepts using technology

The workshops will engage you in active learning, using a variety of formats and teaching strategies that are designed for you to adapt and use in your own classrooms, with time devoted to reflection on how to best adapt and use ideas with your learners.

As you will be working with on-line resources and making digital materials, you will need to bring a laptop or tablet and a smartphone and headphones.

## 2. Lecture & Discussion: The Education System & The Place of New Technologies

3. **Lecture & discussion** with a headteacher on their school's approach to using technology in various subjects, including strategies for using technology to improve learning outcomes for pupils with learning difficulties (2 week term-time courses only)

4. **Visits to 2 primary or secondary schools or adult education colleges** (2 week term-time courses only)  
Observe lessons where technology is in use in the classroom and lessons in the subject(s) requested by each participant.

5. **Illustrated Lecture on Welsh or Irish History, Culture & Traditions** (Cardiff & Dublin 2 week courses only)

6. **Educational visits** to Welsh Open Air Museum & St Fagans Castle and the Welsh Assembly from Cardiff and to Winchester from Southampton  
to Glendalough monastic site & lakes and Powerscourt Gardens from Dublin (certain 2 week courses)

(a) **COURSE FEE:** to include:

Full programme of study sessions and visits as itemised above.

NB. Participants are responsible for paying their own daily transport costs, including transport to schools.

Optional visits are not included in the price.

(b) **HOST FAMILY ACCOMMODATION:** to include:

Full board accommodation with a local family (inclusive of registration fee): 7 or 12 nights

(Teachers may request to be the only guest of their mother tongue or to stay in the same family as a colleague).

Host families are carefully selected and offer a friendly welcome and opportunities to chat and learn more about life in Britain or Ireland today.

Participants often find that the experience of staying with a host family is one of the most memorable aspects of the course. Accommodation is in single rooms (unless participants request to share). Breakfast, packed lunch and evening meal are provided by the host family. (Food allergies, likes and dislikes are taken into account.)

Please note that many of the suitable residential areas are not within walking distance of the town centre, and most host families are an easy bus ride from the town centre/tuition centre. Local transport from host families to the town centre and local schools is at the participants' own expense and is likely to cost 15-40 Euro per week.

Additional nights with host families can be arranged, giving participants extra time for individual research and visits. Accommodation can be provided for family members (but not unaccompanied children) subject to availability. (Rates on request).

## LOCATIONS:

**CARDIFF, Wales:** Population: 357,000; 150 miles (240 kilometres) from London (2¼ hours by rail). Cardiff, the capital city of Wales, situated on the south coast of Wales, is a lively cultural centre. Its attractions include: Cardiff Bay, Cardiff Castle, National Museum and Gallery and Llandaff Cathedral. Nearby are the Open-Air Museum of Welsh Life, Caerphilly Castle, the Brecon Beacons National Park and beautiful coastal scenery and beaches.

The most convenient airports: Cardiff Airport (rail or bus to city centre), Heathrow or Bristol Airports (direct National Express coach from both to Cardiff)



**SOUTHAMPTON, England:** Population: 254,000; 80 miles (128 kilometres) south-west of London (1¼ hours by rail). Southampton is a pleasant university town and an important port situated on the south coast, within easy reach of the New Forest, Winchester, Salisbury, Portsmouth, Bournemouth and the Isle of Wight. There is an historic old town with interesting museums, a new waterside development and an excellent shopping centre.

The most convenient airports: Southampton (rail to city centre), Heathrow (direct National Express coach to Southampton) or Gatwick (direct coach or rail to Southampton)



**DUBLIN, Ireland:** Population: 1,228,000.

Famous for its cultural heritage and charming hospitality, Dublin is a lively city with a rich history, situated on the east coast of Ireland. Notable historic sights include its elegant Georgian squares, Dublin Castle, Christ Church Cathedral, the Book of Kells at Trinity College, Kilmainham Gaol and National Museums. Temple Bar is a busy riverside neighbourhood with live Irish folk music venues. Close to the city are the beautiful hills and lakes of Wicklow Mountains National Park and attractive coastal scenery.
