



Semi-intensive French (FSI)

This course was designed for young au pair girls and other non francophones residents of our region who wish to take French lessons over a long period of time in addition to their main activity. The Institute gives priority to international groups which encourage intercultural exchanges and the use of French as the common language.

Objectives FSI:

- Improve in written expression, grammar and vocabulary
- Upgrade communication capacity
- Training of the use of spoken French in everyday situations
- To insure of a good structure of the language thanks to a long term immersion
- Improve knowledge in areas such as French political, social and cultural life

TEACHERS	Two teachers alternately co-animate and coordinate their training in each group. All our teachers have a "FLE Maîtrise Diploma" (4 years of university studies with 2 years of specialized studies in teaching French as a Foreign Language)		
GROUP PLACEMENT	On the first day, each new student will do a written and oral evaluation in order to organize the groups.		
CERTIFICATE	On the day of departure, each participant will receive a certificate indicating the number of lessons and the duration of the course as well as the level of French reached based on the European Council Reference Grid. On request, a personal report can be given to students who wish to receive one.		

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
