### **COMMUNICATING** UNDER PRESSURE



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How we talk and how we listen are inherently important, however, when the stakes are high, our communication and listening skills become even more critical. Everyone reaches a point where they can no longer endure. It is common to have misunderstandings during stressful moments, which can sometimes add to the stress of the situation. When things get tough, it's a good idea to **reassess how we communicate.** When you perform well under pressure, it builds trust in the team and gives people confidence in your abilities to not only lead, but also to assist them during difficult moments.

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Speaking carefully, listening effectively, and respond accurately are the three principles for good communication, whether we're dealing with coworkers, headmasters, students, or parents.

Effective communication starts with careful speaking. When you are communicating effectively, you are giving your undivided attention to the person with whom you are communicating, therefore it also demands listening effectively. Good communication is a two-way street and therefore requires you to speak in a way that will encourage others to express their thoughts and feelings.

When communicating effectively, you need to respond accurately. In other words, when someone has given you information or asked you a question, your responses should be complete and accurate. If not, they are not helpful or appropriate in the situation.

#### Effective communication is a highly important skill that can improve your relationships with others. It is important for business, social and personal matters.

You also need to be aware of its effect on others! If you are communicating effectively, you are helping others to effectively communicate with you.

When the pressure is on, stop. Breathe. And communicate effectively!

#### **Course Objectives**

The course's main goal is for participants to identify areas of improvement and how to become effective communicators in stressful situations. The learning environment includes instruction, exercises, small and large group discussions, and lots of hands-on practice. Our goal is to help our participants to develop skills for how to handle pressure and fortify their confidence.


### **ACTIVE LISTENING** & EFFECTIVE QUESTIONING



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Being able to listen well and ask questions effectively is a core skill of every role in every workplace. In some roles, this becomes a crucial skill.

Effective listening and questioning techniques are two of the most powerful skills coaches use to help educators obtain knowledge, deepen understanding, refine skills, reflect on instructional practices, and learn how to successfully communicate with students and colleagues.

**Course Objectives:** In this module, coaches explore the fundamental steps necessary when it comes to planning, cultivating, monitoring and maintaining teachers' ongoing cognitive growth and verbal interactions.

Teachers, school staff and others need to be versed in the functions, features, and purposes of communication and be able to model good communication skills when working within and across diverse groups. In addition, professional conversations are a necessary tool to assist teachers in mediating their own learning processes and, in turn, mediating the learning processes of their students.

# **BULLYING & CYBERBULLYING**



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Nowadays, bullying is a frequent threat to the physical and mental integrity of our students, especially during teen years.

This type of school violence is evidenced through a set of aggressive, intentional and repetitive behaviors, from students' individual or collective initiative, addressed to one or several other students. The adolescent (or child) is subject to insults, jokes, ridicule, vexatious attitudes, negative nicknames, etc. Cyberbullying has come to amplify this serious issue, through social networks and other technological means.

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Today, the vast majority of children and young people have access to the Internet at home. Most of them have a computer, tablet or smartphone and are constantly online. Without parents and teachers' monitoring and information, children can become more vulnerable in an extremely complex and dangerous world. Cyber safety and prevention mechanisms can be important tools to reduce this social phenomenon's occurrence.

**Course objectives:** sensitize-teachers about the potential risks and impacts of such actions on the psychological and physical health of young students. This course also aims to train teachers in the prevention, detection and action against threats of this nature, always trying to share and disseminate good practices. Bullying and cyberbullying can be considerably reduced, and ideally prevented, dissuading this culture among children and adolescents, and implementing official mechanisms for monitoring these issues, whenever necessary.

### CLIL TECHNIQUES & ICT



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CLIL has 3 main characteristics: students learn the target language through which the content is taught; it responds to the EU lifelong learning program proposal for all citizens, where multilingualism and multiculturalism is thought to promote integration, understanding and mobility among Europeans; and finally, it involves the development of social, cultural, cognitive, linguistic, academic and other learning skills, which in turn facilitate achievements in both content and language.

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### **COACHING** A POWERFUL TOOL



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We are living in a new age. Fast-changing technology has led to a free flow of information, creating a huge challenge for educators to understand the needs, interests and capabilities of the youth of today.

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Reducing early school leaving is one of the priorities of the Europe 2020 Strategic framework for Education and Training, as well as Erasmus +. This course will introduce participants to the Grow coaching techniques along with emotional freedom techniques. Aggressive behavior and bullying inside and outside the classroom will be analyzed as well.

Participants will learn how to manage and reduce stress levels, thereby improving not only their overall health but also their day-to-day interaction with students and colleagues (by applying communication techniques in order to reduce early school leaving). Well-trained teachers can better meet students' learning expectations!

**Course Objectives:** create trust, motivate and empower teams. We need to empower positive values even if the conditions are not ideal, even if we have to deal with cultural diversity and differences in values. It's about managing techniques and how to use them for you and your organization's benefit. ### FOR EUROPEAN TEACHERS

# CONFLICT MANAGEMENT IN SCHOOLS



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To live in society requires to successfully conduct oneself through the daily conflicts and challenges of life.

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A school's primary function is to prepare students, teachers and parents to adapt and overcome the challenges and struggles of a world full of rapid changes and interpersonal conflicts, contributing to the individual's development process.

Conflict cannot and will not cease to exist, as it is intrinsic to human behaviour and an integral part of moral and emotional growth. Therefore, conflict is present in all schools. It is important to face conflict and resolve it with skills to manage it properly and constructively, establish cooperative relationships, and produce integrative solutions. Harmony and appreciation should coexist in a classroom environment and conflict should not interfere, negatively, in the teaching and learning process.

Each school has a micro-level society, in which relationships are primarily defined based on relative hierarchical positions, and yet, these are dynamic, constantly reflecting changes. Since school environments are different, in order to deal with conflicts inside the school's microsociety teachers need to find approaches that help them understand the circumstances more effectively, identify which strategies better apply to the conflict and make better use of their strengths and weaknesses.

**Course Objectives:** The teacher has a central role to play as far as school conflict is concerned and to successfully handle conflict and pass on that knowledge to students, the teacher must seek to learn the know-how embedded in conflict management theories, apply it to each situation and understand the rationale behind the various conflict management spectrums. Especially, as it pertains to the school precinct and classroom learning environments.

The course aims to bring a clement environmental condition for effective learning and teaching to take place, helping to establish and maintain peaceful and harmonious co-existence between the school's human resources.



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
### HALLO, WIE GEHT'S DIR? GERMAN LEARNING


### SOFT SKILLS FOR TEACHING TECHNIQUES



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Soft skills are personal attributes, as well as personality traits, social skills and communication skills. They characterize how an individual interacts with peers within and outside the work environment.

Different from the so-called hard skills, soft skills involve emotions and intuition, both responsible for the ability to express and interpret the feelings of another person. Teachers need to be highly skilled in all these areas to be excellent in their profession.

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For a teacher, it's not just important to give a quality lecture; they also need to be able to transfer knowledge, skills and values at the same time. Soft skills for teachers are thus as important as their in-depth knowledge on a the particular subject. It is only through soft skills that a teacher can introduce creative and effective solutions to the students' problems.

**Course objectives:** The course's main goal is to develop and acquire effective soft skills. The course focuses on improving techniques and practical activities that teachers can use in a classroom context, whilst expanding their ideas so they can teach engaging and informative lessons.
