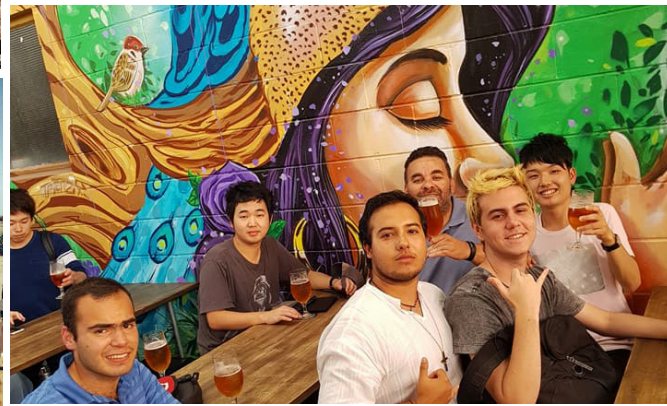
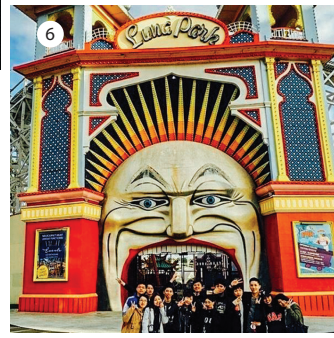
All student visa holders in Australia have the right to work up to 40 hours every two weeks while they study, and full-time during scheduled breaks.

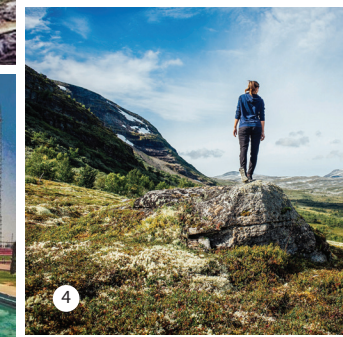
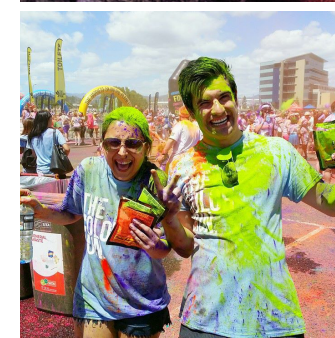
