

Bowling

Bowling is a frequent teacher-led activity in York and a great opportunity to meet new people, hang out with friends and practise English in real-life. Clifford's Tower

Clifford's Tower stands on top of a large earth mound and is the largest remaining part of York Castle, built by William the Conqueror. You can walk along the river or enjoy a boat tour, which are both popular activities in the spring and summer months.
