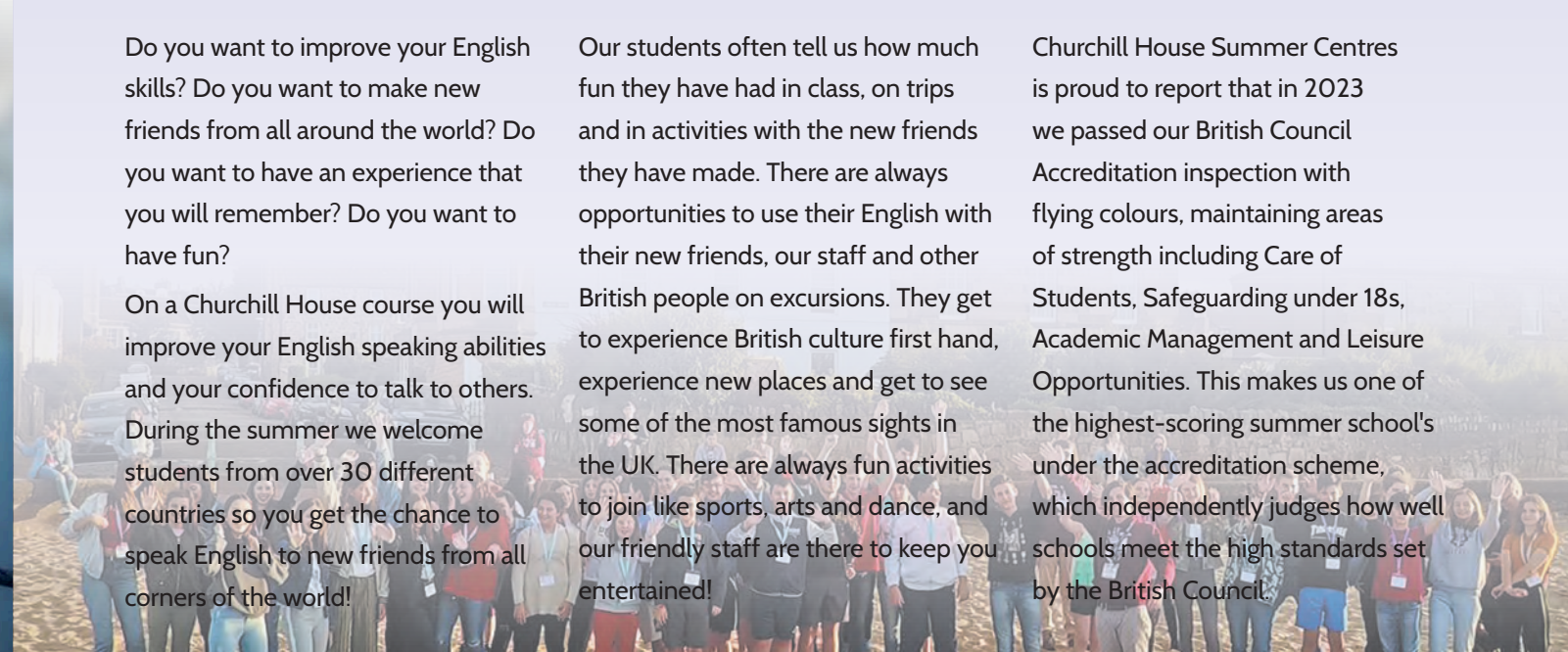
ARE YOU READY FOR CHURCHILL HOUSE?

RAMSGATE HOMESTAY

Staying with a local homestay gives students the opportunity to practise English in an everyday setting, outside the classroom. Students have the opportunity to share cultural experiences, learn more about Britain and improve their language skills – an experience that will stay with them for a lifetime.

Churchill House has been providing homestay accommodation for over fifty years and understands the importance of a safe and friendly environment for our students. Homestay gives students the opportunity to experience the English way of life first hand and to practise English outside the classroom. All families providing homestay accommodation are carefully selected by our experienced Accommodation Managers and are revisited every year.

Our families do everything they can to welcome students to their friendly homes and to make their stay happy and successful. Students can choose a shared or single room – shared is usually with a student of a different nationality so they can speak English together.

Homestay is a safe and enriching way to learn English as such, families provide breakfast and evening meals each day in the family home. The families also provide a weekly personal laundry service. Many families are within 20 minutes' walk of the school or on the main bus route. As you would expect, we work closely with all our host families to ensure that all accommodation meets our very high standards.

The welfare of our homestay students is our prime concern. From the moment they arrive in the UK until they return home, our experienced staff will be available to help them with any problems they might have and encourage them to enjoy their stay with us.

RAMSGATE HOMESTAY BY THE BEACH

Most of our families in Ramsgate host our students all year round and so are used to welcoming new students into their homes. Students are fully immersed into the family environment, eating with the family seven days a week, attending school based evening activities 4 nights a week and staying with their homestay family on Saturday and Sunday evenings. This allows them to get to know the family better and gives them the opportunity to improve their conversation skills in a natural environment. Most of our accommodation is within a 20-minute



walk (or a short bus ride) from the school and at the end of evening activities, our staff walk junior students home.

Churchill House is located in a quiet residential area less than 10 minutes' walk

from the town centre. The school is in an attractive nineteenth century square overlooking public tennis courts and the harbour. The main building dates from 1814 and although it has been modernised it still retains its charm. Classes and activities will take place across the square in one of our school buildings with spacious, modern classrooms. Close to the classes is our Clubroom, with a range of facilities including a self-service restaurant and in the evenings it can be the venue for our disco and karaoke nights.



Classes

Our updated syllabus focuses on speaking and communication. Students also complete a project to class about the excursion locations every week.

Students learn in classes with a maximum of 15 students. Throughout the week, students receive 15 hours of tuition where they are encouraged to develop and practise their English skills through activities that will help them to communicate more confidently.



Activities and Excursions

All of our students are encouraged to actively use their English, not only through classes, but also through the activity programme and excursions. Each student visits fun and educational places on one half day and one full day trip a week, which allows them to interact with other British people and use their English.

Accommodation

Our excellent residential facilities accommodate up to 120 students in modern comfortable rooms. Plumpton College provides mainly single bedrooms in separate male and female accommodation blocks, and all bathrooms are shared between 4-6 students. Laundry is available onsite and free of charge.

Students are housed dependent on their age and gender. Our bedrooms have communal bathing and toilet facilities.



TEACHING & LEARNING

RAISING CONFIDENCE IN COMMUNICATION

Our Summer English courses concentrate on improving a student's level of fluency and to raising their confidence in speaking English. We do this by focussing on speaking and listening activities to bring out what they already know and develop their skills. Students are actively encouraged to practise their English with students from other nationalities, both in class and outside.

Students are tested on arrival to the centre so that we can accurately assess the student's level and place them in an appropriate class. We keep class sizes small; average 13 students per class but 15 maximum. This allows us to pay more attention to each individual student.

Our teachers are qualified and enthusiastic,

helping the students to learn as much useful English as possible. They make lessons interesting and fun, using a wide range of language activities designed to improve their ability to communicate fluently.

Our Classic English courses include 15 hours of English tuition per week including fluency practice, project work where students work together on topics such as the environment, well being and British Culture, which allows them to use a range of language skills to deliver a presentation at the end of the week. The project is based on the excursion locations encouraging the students to get the most from their trips. Most of our schools have lessons in the morning, though in

some schools we may operate a zig-zag programme, which means classes can be in the morning or afternoon. At the end of the course the student receives an individual progress report written by their teacher and an end-of-course achievement certificate.

STUDENT WELFARE

OUR PRIME CONCERN

The welfare of our homestay and residential students is our prime concern, from the moment they arrive in the UK until they return home. Our staff ensure that our students are safe, happy and cared for during their stay; providing full and attentive supervision. The centres have at least two first-aid trained staff available at all times.

Food

On our residential courses, all meals are prepared by the centre and eaten in the dining hall. On full day and extended day excursions, packed meals are provided. The food is always high quality, offering

a good variety of the necessary well-balanced and healthy diet students' require.

Most dietary requirements can be catered for with advance notice. Please tell your sales consultant of any allergies or requirements needed at the time of booking.

Insurance

All students, whether an individual or group student, are strongly advised to have insurance for the duration of their stay covering them for medical expenses, course cancellation, personal accident, personal liability, loss of baggage, personal

effects, money and tickets.

TRANSFER SERVICE

Travelling to a new country is exciting but it can also be stressful. We understand this and have many years experience in providing a transfer service to make travel to your centre easy and safe.

Our 'Meet and Greet' transfer service is a safe and secure way to reach your centre. We have a transfer team at the two main London airports (Heathrow & Gatwick) so there is always a friendly face to meet you. There is no need to worry if your flight is delayed – we guarantee there will be someone waiting for you no matter how long it takes. After being met a transfer team member will guide you safely through the airport to your coach or taxi and make sure you travel smoothly on to your centre. We provide the same level of care on departure and one of our transfer team will always be with you through check-in to security, even if your flight is delayed.

For groups we can provide private coach transfers from any UK airport. Individual students can choose private taxi transfers from all airports or shared transfers (which are cheaper) from Heathrow & Gatwick. Shared transfer students are met on arrival by one of our transfer team and supervised until boarding their transport. For children who fly as Unaccompanied Minors we provide a personal meeting and accompanying service at the airport on arrival and departure during our shared transfer times.

For residential centres arrival and departure day are on Sundays. Homestay students should arrive on a Sunday and leave on a Saturday.

Individual Students please note

Our shared transfers leave the airport between 09:00 and 17:00 so choose your flight time to match. On departure days your return flight must leave between 11:00 and 18:00. Our taxi service is available on any arrival or departure

days for flights between 08:00 & 20:00 (flight arrival & departure times) although other times may be possible. Private transfers can be arranged to/from any location (airport, railway station, ferry port etc.) – please contact our Transfer Department for details.

For Groups

All Group members should arrive and leave together. Your flight should arrive between 09:00 and 18:00 and leave between 11:00 and 22:00. There will be a member of our transfer team at Heathrow and Gatwick between 09:00 & 18:00 to greet your group on arrival. For other airports we provide clear instructions on how to meet your transfer coach.
