

Nota bene:

- The price list is valid from 1 January until 31 December 2026; Euro = European Union Currency.
- Net prices for agencies as well as cancellation conditions are specified in a separate agreement. New business partners, please contact our Marketing Office.
- *) The registration fee is valid for 12 months and must be paid for any enrollment.
- Culture, Art, Music and Fashion courses will take place only with the minimum number of participants indicated.
- Duration of a lesson = 45 minutes (except some Culture, Art and Cooking Courses). Lessons are held from Monday to Friday and can take place either in the morning or in the afternoon. Lessons are not held and not refunded on national and local public holidays.
- Minimum age = 16 years.
- **VISA:** If a visa is requested to study in Italy, each student (or agency) has to contact the nearest Italian Consulate beforehand to complete the formalities. Our certificate of enrollment fulfils one of the requirements to obtain a visa. In order to receive this certificate, the global tuition fees must be paid in advance and in full for the entire period of study.

In case of annulment/cancellation of the booking due to failure to obtain the Visa, whatever the reason for such rejection, the School will refund the amount paid for each course chosen, after receiving a copy of the letter of rejection of the Visa, issued by the Italian Authority (Embassy or Consulate), withholding an administrative tax of 200.00 Euro plus the confirmation deposit of 20% of the full price for each course which has been booked.

The course prices include:

- Placement, assessment and final tests.
- Teaching material (except Fine Arts courses).
- Diploma «Firenze» ALL examination fees for the preparation courses.
- Documents for Visa and Residence Permit, if requested.
Exception: If the Agency, for whatever reason, requires the Visa documents to be sent urgently by fast mail (e.g. express couriers), all the related expenses will be charged on the invoice.



Short description	<p>The CILS certification is an officially recognized qualification and is an important tool for work and also in education and academia.</p> <p>Scuola Leonardo da Vinci is a recognized center, approved by the Università per Stranieri di Siena, for CILS certification exams.</p> <p>The CILS certification is standardized by the “Common European Framework of Reference for Languages (CEFR)” and is divided into various competence levels that this document introduces. The CILS certification levels are as follows: A1-A2 (basic learner), B1-B2 (independent learner, central), C1-C2 (competent learner). In each level the exam is divided into the following sections: written comprehension, writing skills, morphosyntactic skills, listening comprehension, oral production. To pass the exam and receive the certification, you must obtain a sufficient score in each section. If you have reached a sufficient score in only some of the sections, it is still possible to ‘capitalize’ on your positive results and, within a calendar year, you may repeat the test only for the sections in which you had not previously reached the minimum score required to pass.</p> <p>The CILS is the first certification of Italian to have achieved these specific modules for foreign workers in Italy. It is important to remember that the CILS A2 module integration is recognized by the Ministry of Foreign Affairs for ‘Fluency in Italian’. This is helpful for obtaining the residence permit for long period stays.</p>							
Course Preparation	<p>Scuola Leonardo da Vinci organizes specific courses for those who want to obtain the CILS certification. These courses are held during the weeks immediately prior to the exam dates established by the Università per Stranieri di Siena and aim to provide thorough preparation with regard to the different skills required. The preparation analyzes and tests the evidence of previous examinations, while also identifying specific problems that the teacher may identify.</p>
