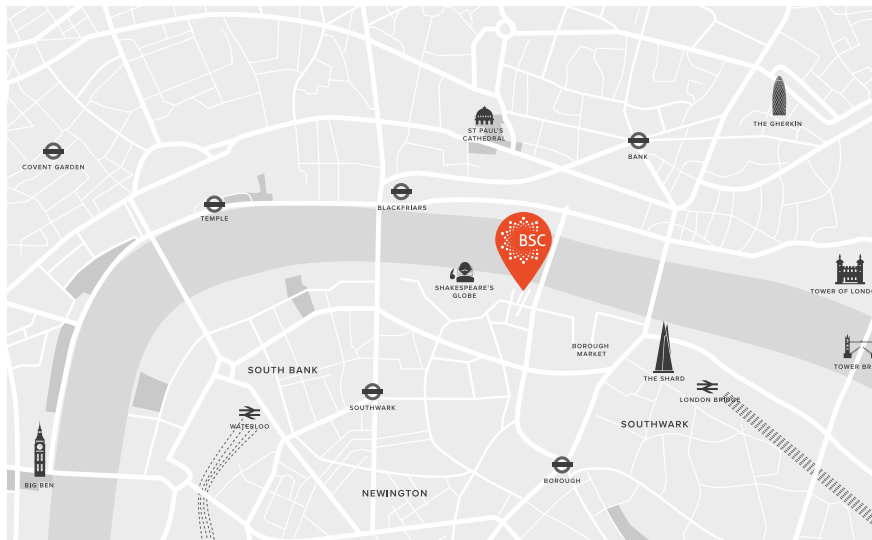

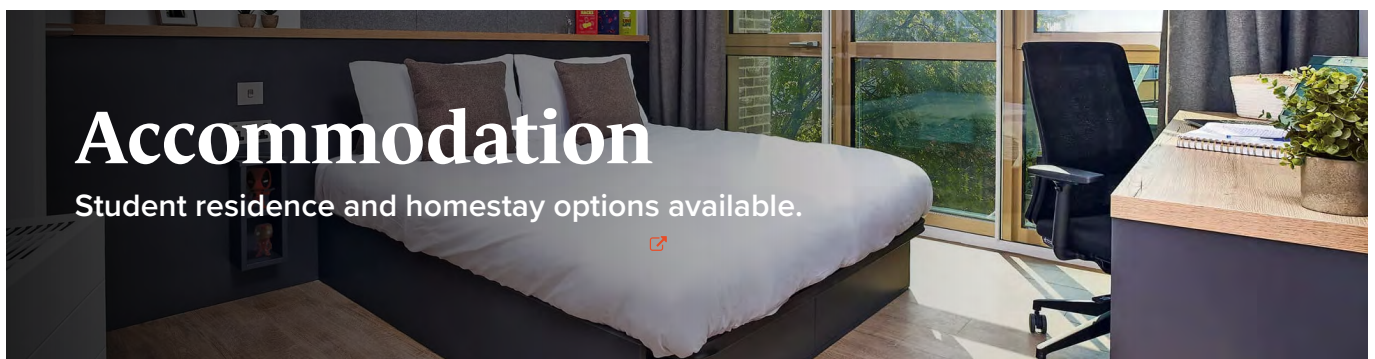

## Getting around London

BSC London is located at Bankside, close to Shakespeare's Globe Theatre, Tate Modern and London Bridge. London has a large selection of public transport options, allowing you to explore the city. Depending on where you are travelling from and what form of transportation you use, the daily cost of travel may vary. [↗](#)

**By Underground:** London Bridge (10 minute walk from school). Services from this station include the Jubilee Line and Northern Line. Visit Transport for London to view live tube updates and to plan your journey.

**By River:** Travel in style along the River Thames, with the Bankside Pier stop just a 1 minute walk from the school. Services from this stop include Westminster, London Eye and Canary Wharf.
