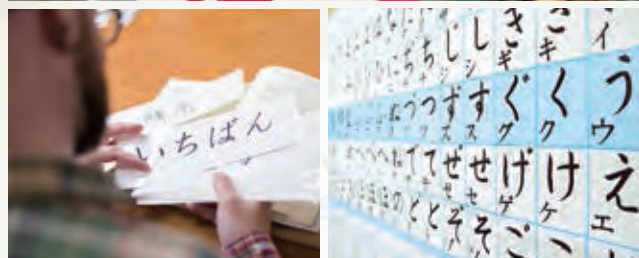

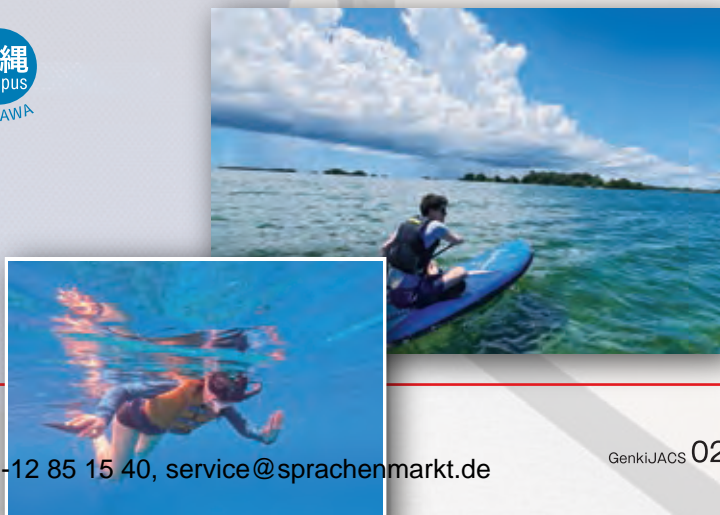


## Plus Marine and Nature Activities

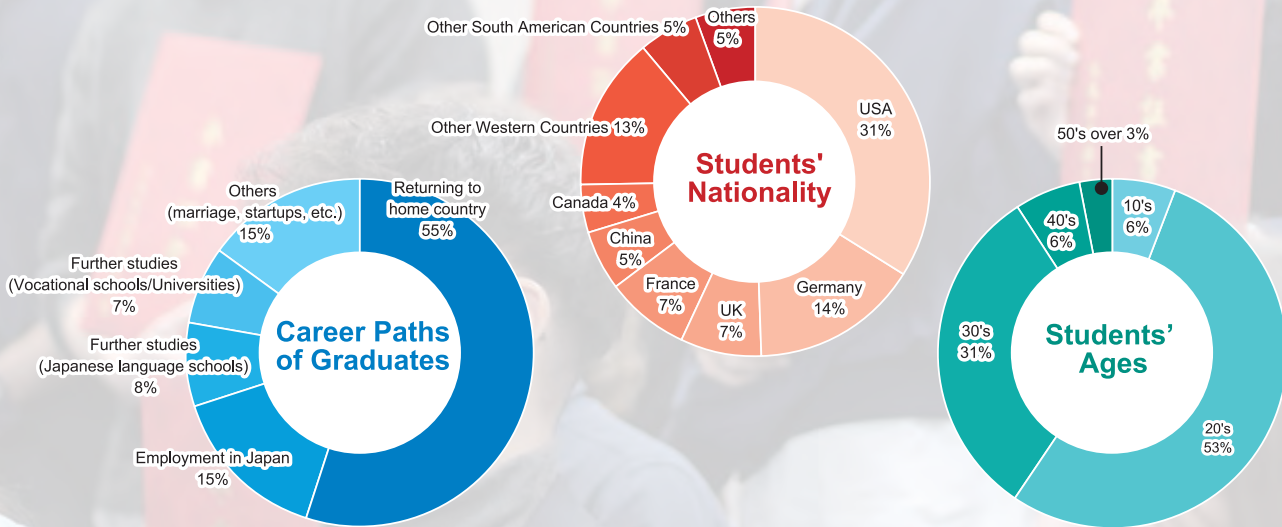


## Long-term Course



1-year / 18-month | Student visa support available in Fukuoka | Start date: April and October

This course maintains GenkiJACS's core approach of small classes with a maximum of 9 students and a focus on practical Japanese skills, while allowing students to stay in Japan for an extended period to study the language, culture, and society more deeply. The 1-year course includes 40 weeks of classes, and the 18-month course includes 60 weeks, with four Japanese lessons per day. Classes go beyond the classroom, offering cultural and social experiences as well as opportunities to interact with Japanese people. The course schedule includes several weeks of holidays, giving students time to explore their own interests and deepen their knowledge of Japan. Most students attend for self-improvement and language learning, rather than for university or career purposes.



## Summer Course for Minors

Available in Fukuoka in July, and in Kyoto in July and August



This package course is specially designed for teenage students. Along with Japanese lessons, it's packed with exciting activities! Accommodations are carefully selected homestays with Japanese families, giving you a safe and immersive experience of daily life and culture in Japan.

During the course, you'll meet fellow students from around the world as well as local Japanese students — an opportunity to make lifelong friends!

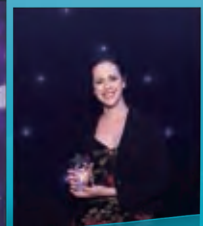
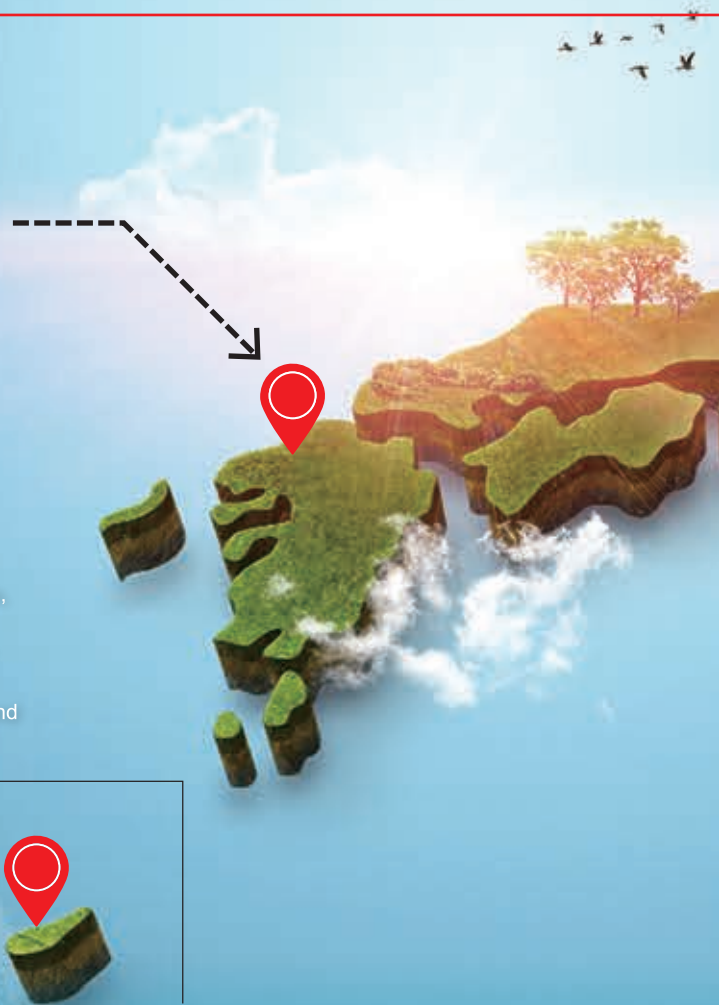

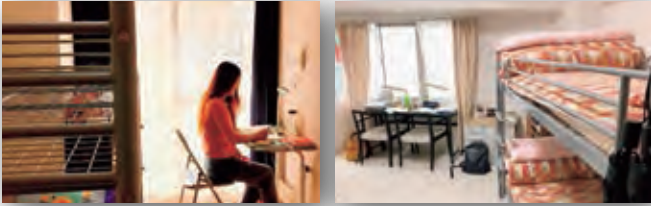
## School Dormitory

This course is recommended for those planning to continue to higher education in artistic fields such as illustration, design, film, and more.





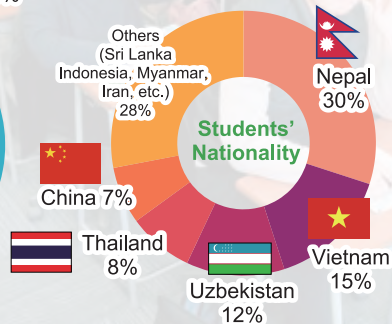
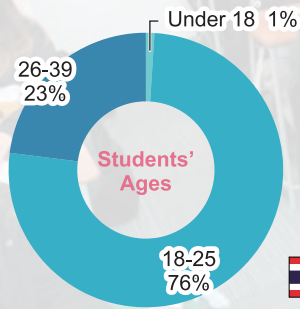

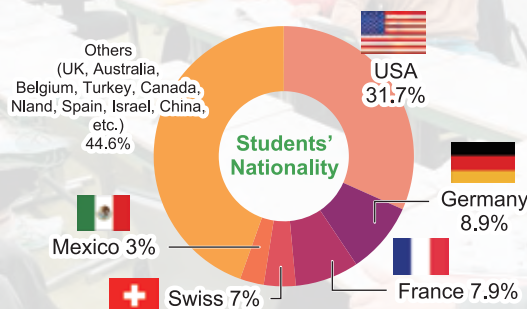
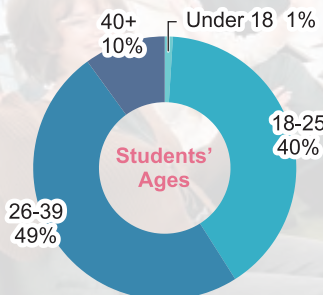
## General Japanese Course

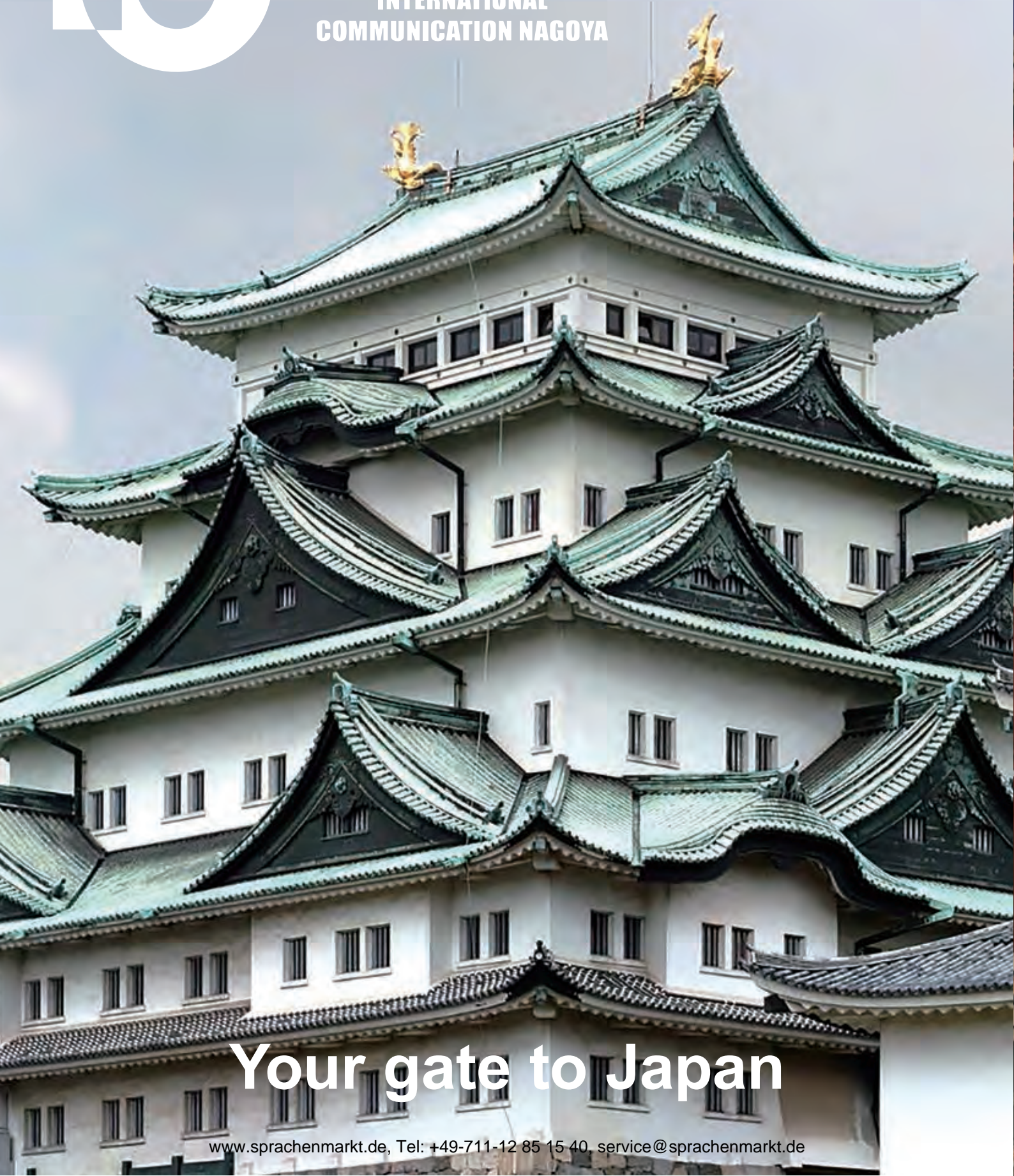
