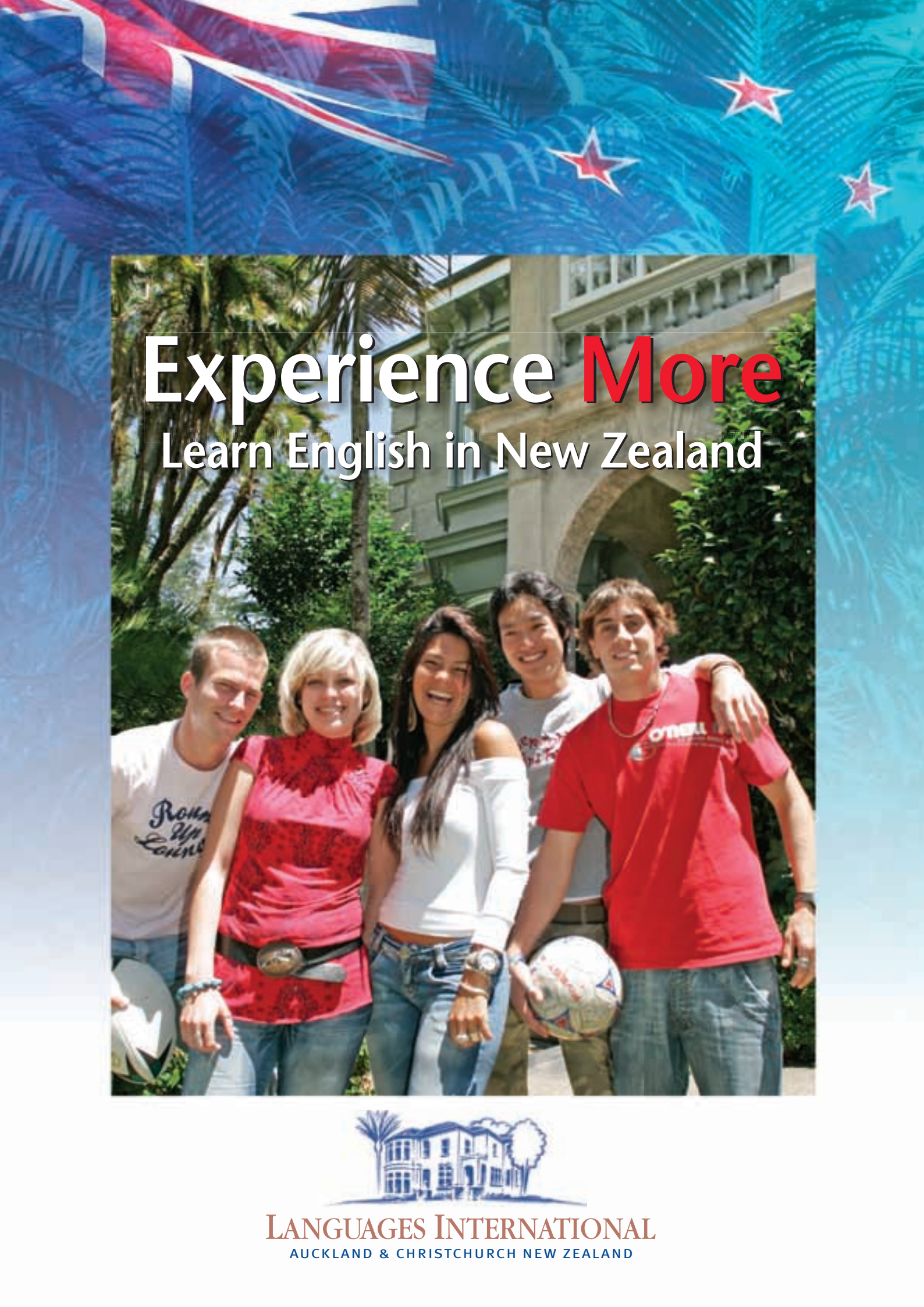

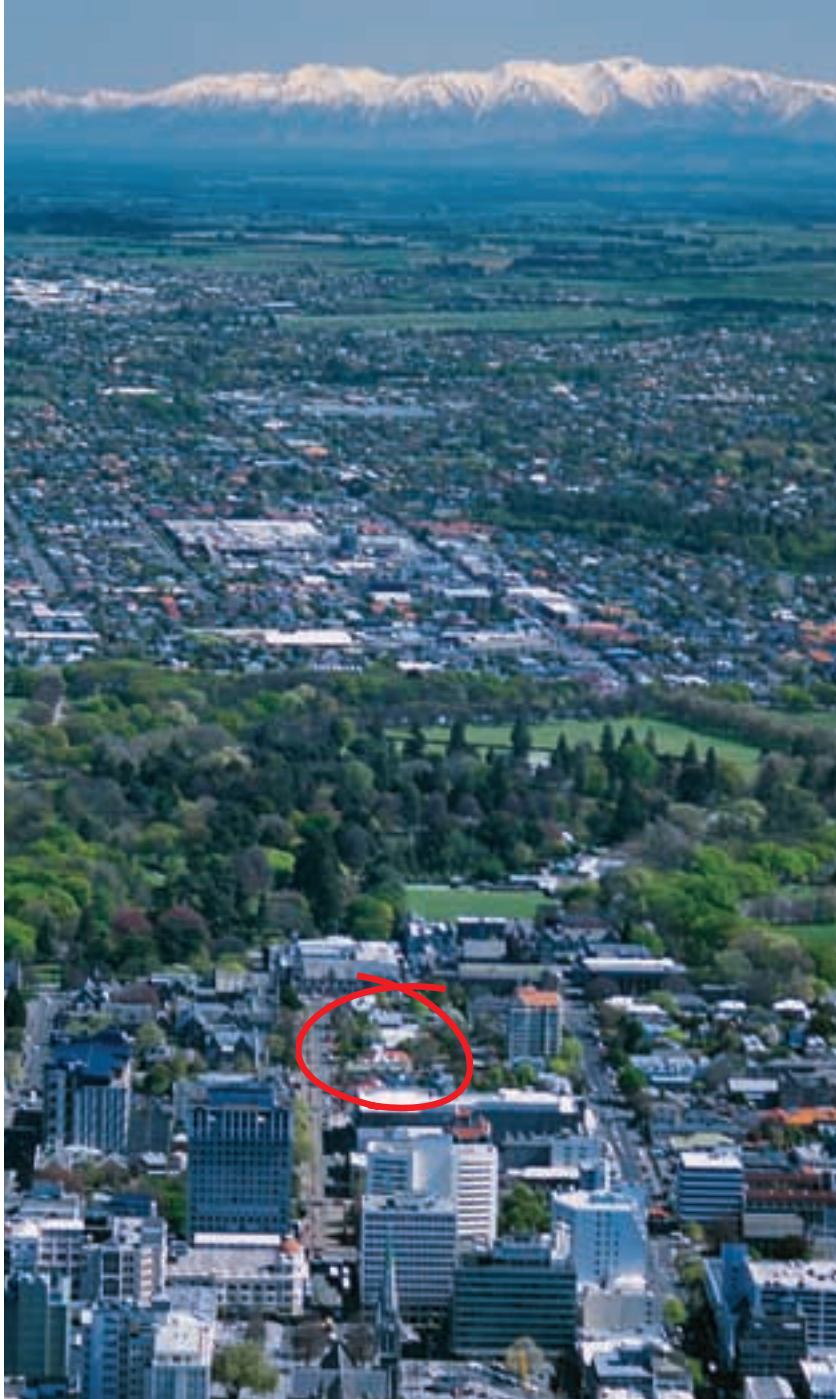

Academic Programme

Courses

Our school year is divided into Summer, Autumn, Winter and Spring Quarters. A full General English course for each level lasts for one Quarter. Starting dates for all courses are listed in each year's Course Information document.

General English

These courses will help you communicate more fluently and accurately in English. They are available as full-time (23 hours per week) or part-time (13 hours per week). We offer classes at eight internationally recognised levels from beginner to post-advanced. Teachers follow a detailed syllabus using a textbook together with other in-class activities. You can be assured of interesting and effective lessons.

English for Business

Courses in English language for use in commercial and professional environments are available as full-time or part-time. The courses are offered at intermediate to advanced levels. As part of this course, you can choose to prepare for an international qualification, such as the Cambridge Business English Certificate (BEC).

English for University

This full-time course prepares you for study at universities and polytechnics in New Zealand or other English-speaking countries. The course develops the ability to read academic and technical books and articles; to write essays and reports; to listen to lectures and take notes; and to participate in academic discussions, tutorials and seminars. You can combine this course with preparation for IELTS or TOEFL tests. English for University courses run at two levels. You need to complete the higher level to manage the language requirements of tertiary study. Our English for University staff can help you gain acceptance onto university and polytechnic courses.

Cambridge English Language Certificates

The Cambridge General English and Business exams test your ability in all language skills. We offer a thorough preparation for the following exams:

Preliminary English Test (PET)

First Certificate in English (FCE)

Certificate in Advanced English (CAE)

Certificate of Proficiency in English (CPE)

Business English Certificates (BEC)

Preparation courses for Cambridge FCE, CAE and CPE exams are all full-time. Languages International guarantees the availability of preparation courses for each FCE, CAE and CPE exam date.

IELTS

This examination is used to test English for entry to higher education courses and for immigration. Students usually combine IELTS preparation with the English for University course. Languages International is noted for the thoroughness of its courses preparing students for further study.

TOEFL and TOEIC

These intensive courses familiarise you with the TOEFL and TOEIC tests. They are combined with your choice of General English, English for University or English for Business, which will improve your English language skills essential for a good TOEFL or TOEIC score.

Insurance

Students are not entitled to publicly funded health services while in New Zealand. If you receive medical treatment during your visit, you will be liable for the full costs of that treatment. We also strongly recommend that you obtain insurance to cover your travel to and from New Zealand. Languages International can provide comprehensive insurance for your travel and time in New Zealand. It includes medical insurance and a provision for refund of tuition fees in special circumstances.

Accident Insurance: The Accident Compensation Corporation provides accident insurance for all New Zealand citizens, residents and temporary visitors to New Zealand, but you may still be liable for all other medical and related costs.
