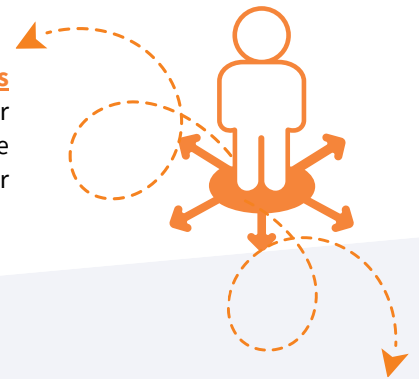

*Toronto and Vancouver students applying for a Study Permit must submit a fee of \$750 CAD (which includes a \$530 Allocation Fee and a \$220 Registration Fee) before the PAL will be issued – both fees are non-refundable.

**For students interested in studying French in Montréal, French is available in the Full-Time Intensive, Full-Time morning, and Part-Time Morning schedules only. Students may start on any Monday, except Beginner 1 level students who must begin on session start dates.

Currently we are unable to issue a CAQ for programs exceeding 26 weeks in Montréal; however, the 26+ week rate may apply when booking multi-location bookings that exceed 26 weeks.

Combine your Greystone College studies with ILSC Full-Time Intensive or Full-Time study for a total combined study length and save money on your ILSC tuition fees:

- If your total combined study length (not including co-op weeks) is 12 weeks, pay the 12 weeks fee for your ILSC study weeks.
- If your total combined study length (not including co-op weeks) is 24+ weeks, pay the 24+ weeks fee for your ILSC study weeks.
