When can new students join our courses?

We follow a similar academic year to state schools and colleges in the UK.

- **Regular daily flights** from London Heathrow (LHR) to Newquay (NQY) - 50 minute flight, then we will pick you up from Newquay airport and it is just 20 minutes to Truro.

- **Airport transfer** from Newquay or Heathrow airport. One of our team will collect you from the airport and bring you directly to the school.
