Language Courses



Groups are formed by taking into account the individual student's characteristics and current knowledge of Italian, as well as thesix levels of European Community Principle General Language Level:

- Base A1: BreakthroughElementary A2: Waystage
- Pre-intermediate B1: Threshold
- Intermediate B2: Vantage
- Upper-intermediate C1: Effective operational profifiency
- Advanced C2: Mastery

An initial welcome language test (oral and written) plus an individual assessment including individual motivation and analysis of needs and skills are part of establishing the plan of study. Individual lessons are arranged if desired/needed.

The language courses are in the morning and after lunch, if one desires to study full-time, we offer a wide range of conversational courses in- and outside of the classroom. We strongly believe it is easier to understand an learn a new language through living the culture. All our instructors have an advanced teaching degree and are highly qualified and specialized in teaching Italian as a foreign language. Our teaching method is dynamic; students are involved and encouraged to participate throughout the lessons. The approach involves both speaking and writing as well as reviewing daily lessons.

Idea Verona collaborates with the Chamber of Commerce of Verona (Verona Innovation), the Chamber of Commerce Italiy-China, the Regional Institute for Education and Cooperative Studies, AIL Diploma of Florence, CILS of the University of Sinea, CELI of the University of Perugia, ESU of the University of Verona, the University of Illinois USA (accrediting their degrees at our school), CSN the Swedish National Agency of Higher Studies and Bildungsurlaub.




Plida Certificate















The school IDEA VERONA is PLIDA Certification Center (Dante Alighieri Italian Language Project) with authorization no. 111392 granted by the Headquarters of the Dante Alighieri Society. The PLIDA certificate attests to the competence of Italian as a foreign language according to the six proposed levels in the Common European Framework of Reference for Languages of the Council of Europe (A1, A2, B1, B2, C1, C2).

The Dante Alighieri Society, founded in 1889 by a group of important Italian intellectuals, aims to "protect and promote the Italian language and culture in the world, reviving the spiritual ties of compatriots abroad with the mother country and nurturing love and reverence for Italian culture among foreigners."

The PLIDA certificate has the following advantages:

- one may indicate more clearly their level of Italian knowledge on their resumes;
- one may enrol in an Italian university without taking the Italian exam (level B2 or C1);
- one may apply for long stay permission (minimum level A2)

The exam is divided into tests that verify language skills in the four basic abilities: Listening, Reading, Writing, Speaking.

Accommodation!



We put the needs of our students first and actual availability into account. The cost varies depending on the length of stay, time of year and the characteristics of the accommodations. The apartments are close to the school and the city centre and are almost all within walking distance (5 to 20 minute walk), and in any case are well served by public transport. The structures and host families are all selected and known personally by the Director of the school Anna Sbampato, which over the years has verified the reliability and quality of reception.

Living with an Italian Family

Students living with host families have the opportunity to experience everyday life in an Italian family. It is the best method to completely immerse oneself in the linguistic environment and allows one to make new friends. All bills are included, except telephone. Breakfast and dinner is included as well.

Sharing an apartment with other students

Shared apartments with other Italian and foreign students, including kitchen and bathroom (linens and towels provided) All bills are included, except telephone.

Living alone in a small apartment

Furnished and self-contained studio or two room flat, always includes room, kitchen and bathroom (linens and towels provided). All bills are included, except telephone.
