Student welfare

Celtic English Academy has a responsibility to provide a safe and caring learning environment for all our students and staff. However, we take extra care of students under the age of 18 and vulnerable adults.



All staff that work with under 18s have thorough background checks, including a check of their criminal history and references from previous employers.



Students under 18 will be asked to wear an orange lanyard so that they can be easily identified by staff.



All staff that work with under 18s have a safeguarding level 1 certificate or higher. This includes support staff as well as teachers.



Students in homestay accommodation will have curfews - 9pm for those aged under 15 and 10pm for those who are 16-17 years old.



During the day, we always have first aid trained staff on hand.



Under 18s are not allowed on trips that are unsuitable for them.



We also have mental health first aiders at our academy.



All under 18s must book an airport transfer through us (unless a guardian is bringing them) to ensure they arrive and get home safely.
