

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WELCOME TO BLS ENGLISH, BURY ST EDMUNDS

Near Cambridge, Bury St Edmunds is a beautiful and historic market town in the county of Suffolk. It plays a very important part in English history. It was here, in 1214, that the barons swore they would force King John to accept the Charter of Liberties, later known as the Magna Carta. King Henry VIII's sister, Mary, is buried in St Mary's Church, and the ruined abbey, with its magnificent gardens, was a shrine to Saint Edmund, king of the East Angles.

Bury St Edmunds has a striking combination of architecture from medieval and elegant Georgian squares and a glorious cathedral with a stunning Millennium tower, to magnificent gardens and ultra modern facilities.

The Moyses Hall Museum dates back to 1180, the Theatre Royal is one of the oldest theatres in England, and the Apex is a new state of the art live entertainment venue. Interestingly the smallest pub in England, the Nutshell, is also in Bury St Edmunds.

Bury St Edmunds has excellent shopping and a wonderful street market on Wednesdays and Saturdays. Leisure facilities include a multiplex cinema complex, an "arts" cinema, theatres, newly designed leisure and fitness centre, great restaurants and pubs in addition to quaint old world shops.

Bury St Edmunds has a population of 45,000 and is on a direct train line and coach service to London. London is 80 miles away, Cambridge 28 miles, Ipswich 26 miles and Newmarket 14 miles. For more information on Bury St Edmunds.

THE ADULT CENTRE

The BLS Adult Centre at No 147 Kings Road is where the adult courses take place. The offices and classrooms are in a prominent Grade II listed Georgian building in the historic centre of the vibrant town. In addition to the spacious well-lit classrooms, there is a quiet learning centre, student common room, picnic garden and a sunny patio. Residential accommodation is available at the BLS Residence in Spring Lane. This is a ten minute walk away in a leafy part of the town.

ADULT GENERAL ENGLISH

WHAT IS THE COURSE STRUCTURF?

Courses at BLS run throughout the year except for a two week break over the Christmas period (the final week of December and the first week of January).

WHEN DO I COMMENCE MY COURSE?

Entry into courses at BLS is very flexible so that you can start your course most Mondays in the year (all Mondays except bank holidays). BLS runs a "rolling registration" system with students able to join at any time of the year. Public and school holidays.

HOW LONG WILL MY STUDIES BE?

- Some students come to BLS for short periods perhaps only two or three weeks. The friendly and hard working atmosphere at BLS encourages students to make progress in a short space of time
- Other students come to us for longer courses very often for one or two 12 week terms – to prepare for one of the international exams
- There are also students who come to us for one or two academic semesters - up to 48 weeks

WHAT IS THE CLASS SIZE?

For most of the year the average number of mixed nationality students in your class will be 9 - the maximum is 15.

WILL MY CURRENT ENGLISH SKILLS BE ASSESSED?

Your English skills will be assessed by our Director of Studies via our online test before you arrive. The Director of Studies will then place you in the most suitable class for you.

Additionally, you will be assessed on your first morning by your teacher so that we have an understanding of your goals and confidence in speaking English.

- Courses have flexible lengths, from two weeks to one year
- Courses start every Monday (except bank holiday Mondays)
- Maximum class size is 15 (average is 9 students)
- 'General English 21' 21 lessons / 16 hours (lessons held in the mornings + 1 unsupervised self study / mock exam on a Friday afternoon)
- 'Semi Intensive English 26' 26 lessons / 20 hours (lessons held in the mornings + 2 afternoons of skills practise (4 hours) + 1 unsupervised self study / mock exam on a Friday afternoon)
- 'Intensive English 32' 32 lessons / 24 hours (lessons held in mornings + 4 afternoons of skills practise (8 hours) + 1 unsupervised self study / mock exam on a Friday afternoon).
- The minimum age is 16 and the average age is 23 years

TUTORIALS

There is the opportunity to have one-to-one tutorials with our Director of Studies – to review your progress and identify areas for individual study.

EXAM PREPARATION

FXAMS

BLS has been preparing students for major English language examinations since 1995. Exam courses remain our focus, of which the two most commonly requested are: IELTS (required to enter UK universities) and Cambridge Exams (FCE, CAE etc). BLS is an authorised Preparation Centre for the Cambridge Examinations.

IELTS

IELTS is an important test of academic English and is used by many universities around the world as an entry requirement. By combining our morning programmes with academic training in the afternoon we are able to offer a year round preparation programme to enable the student to achieve their personal best.

CAMBRIDGE EXAMS

All Adult General English classes at BLS are broadly based on the "communicative" Cambridge Examinations syllabus; which means that even a short stay at BLS will provide General English that forms the basis of the Cambridge exams. In the afternoon classes, the focus is on skills and examination technique in addition to language. Practice of the examination past papers is a key component here. Ideally, a course of twelve weeks is recommended, although it is possible for students to join these courses for shorter periods at any time of the year.

ENGLISH FOR WORK

If you are looking for paid work to help fund your studies, BLS can help you with your applications. You must be entitled to work in the UK and your English level must be at CEFR B1 or higher. Our students work in shops, restaurants, night clubs, hotels, cafes and in many other establishments. A current CV and face-to-face interview is often necessary in order to confirm any paid work placement. BLS will assist you in this.

INTERNSHIPS AT BLS

BLS offers regular unpaid internships that can combine study with work all year round. Gain an insight into the various departments at BLS and support either the academic, accommodation, administration or marketing department. In return, Interns will receive a stipend and accommodation in the residence. More details and job description available on request.

THE ACADEMIC YEAR

Are you planning to go on to an English-speaking university, or hoping to move on to an international job? Whatever your plans you will be making BLS English your home for six months or more. It is very important to us that every aspect of your stay is as comfortable and beneficial to you as possible.

All students at BLS English receive individual tutorials with the Director of Studies to discuss their progress and assess whether they are on course to achieve their agreed targets.

University application: We will give you help and advice in regards to your university application if this is needed.

For students requiring longer courses, BLS recommends the academic semester course of 24 weeks. Students can choose our 'General 21', 'Semi Intensive 26' or Intensive 32' course. Our academic year is divided into three terms: autumn (14 weeks), winter (12 weeks) and spring (12 weeks).

WORK EXPERIENCE

BLS English works closely with local businesses and can offer programmes of study and unpaid work in order for you to gain valuable life skills and improve your career planning. Study in the morning and join a local company in the afternoons for a full-time programme that will introduce you to the world of work

WORK AND STUDY COURSE

- Course available to individual adult students, and to groups of up to 25 people.
- 30 certifiable hours in total
 - 15 hours General English
 - 15 hours of voluntary work experience placement in a local business
- Typical placements include shops, cafes, bars, restaurants, shops, offices, salons.

Applicants must be 16+, an EU citizen and have CEFR B2 or higher level of English – English level is tested before placement via our online assessment and Skype interview with our dedicated Work Experience Coordinator.

For students younger than 16 years old, or who need to improve their English skills before entering a work experience placement, our Introduction to Work course is the course for you

ENGLISH FOR TEACHERS (AUGUST) WHO SHOULD LOOK AT THIS COURSE?

For group leaders who also teach in their home country, this course is designed with professional development in mind. It allows you the opportunity to practise and improve your English language knowledge and at the same time develop your teaching practice. In the mornings you will join one of our General English classes and in the afternoons you will take part in a programme of observations, workshops and group discussions on various aspects of teaching methodology and practice, including theory and practical aspects.

Participants will learn about the history of these iconic British marques, discuss road tests of the cars and materials from the era and enjoy looking back to these heady days. Participants will get to see privately owned car collections, fascinating "secret Suffolk" motor museums, visit a real garage working on old cars, and enjoy drives in the stunning Suffolk countryside in the "fleet" of classic cars. There will be a full day excursion to a British Motor Museum. Course would suit mature adults 50+.

PASSION FOR FOOTBALL

(1 or 2 weeks in May - see website for dates)

Passionate about the beautiful game? Are you a football fan? You do not need to have played to enjoy this wonderful sport. What better place to share your passion than in England, the home of football. You will learn all about what makes the English so crazy about football. The journey will begin with our amateur local team in Bury St Edmunds, then you will move through the divisions to see what the lower leagues have to offer football fans. You will watch from the terraces, learn the chants, and understand what it means to be a football fan in England. Our local professional teams are Cambridge United, Ipswich Town and Norwich City. Tour the grounds and learn about how important football is to East Anglia. On the final Saturday why not stay an extra night and go to the FA Cup Final?

PASSION FOR HORSES

(1 or 2 weeks in May - see website for dates)

Passionate about horses, horse racing and the wonderful animal itself? This course is for lovers of the horse keen to improve their English. The focus of the daily English lessons will be on vocabulary and fluency exercises connected to the subject of the horse. You will visit the brand new worldclass National Heritage Centre for Horseracing and Sporting Art in Newmarket - the historic home of the 'sport of kings'. You will be taken to the newly re-opened racing palace of King Charles II which includes: a national Gallery of British Sporting Art with loans from private and public collections across the UK including Tate Britain. The new National Horseracing Museum uses the latest visual technology to tell the story of horseracing from its earliest origins to the present day and the science behind the thoroughbred. Watch live displays of successfully retrained racehorses in the arena and ride a winner on the racehorse simulator in the Kings Yard. You will also tour the training grounds run by Jockey Club Estates where the world's finest racehorses are trained and visit the National Stud to be introduced to its breeding programmes. Enjoy a day at the races? An afternoon of horse riding? These will be options. BLS Passion for Horses course - for a mature adult market.

Residential Accommodation is available year round for students aged 18 plus. There are two en-suite rooms and three with shared bathroom - all single occupancy. Prices available on our website.

Accommodation is self-catering and there is a suitably-equipped communal kitchen and dining area.

Spring Lane Cottage is only 10 minutes walk to the main shops, cinema, sports centre, restaurants and bars.

Bedding is provided and students are able to do their own laundry using the free on-site machines. Students are requested to provide their own towels. There is a weekly cleaning service in the bedrooms.

Homestay accommodation for our adult students is within 30 minute walking distance of the school and mostly in and around the town centre. Our Accommodation Coordinator carefully matches each student with their host. Please let us know when you register if you have any allergies or preferences. We will send you a profile of the Homestay we have selected for you about 2 weeks before you arrive and once your fees have been received.

Your Host will provide you with a bed, breakfast, a packed lunch to bring to school and an evening meal each day. Your Host will provide towels and bedding and will offer you a weekly laundry service. You will have access to bath or shower facilities every day.

Adult students always have their own room. Some hosts can accommodate more than one student at the same time, but never two students that have the same mother tongue unless specifically requested.

A TYPICAL WEEK

Students can sign up to a wide range of extra activities and trips by checking the information board in the common room. Here there will be the option to sign up to various activities and trips. The price will be listed and it is often a case of pay as you go. Examples with costs can be found on our website.

THE STUDENT COMMON AREAS



SPORTS


