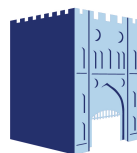

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Junior Summer Programme

Enjoy improving your English and meeting people from different countries. The course combines intensive English with cultural activities, sports and social events. The excursions to world famous cities such as London and Cambridge are integrated into the course. You will have the opportunity to experience English daily life by staying in host accommodation.

21 hours of lessons + 4 hours of supervised homework club

Weekly progress tests

1 full day excursion each Saturday (1 per 2 weeks / 2 per 3 weeks)

1 half day cultural excursion each week

2 evening social activities each week

1 afternoon per week of martial arts, escape rooms, sports, drama, arts and craft or baking

Arrive Sunday, depart Saturday

Accommodation

Host or Residential accommodation is available throughout the summer. On registration you can tell us if you have any special requests and our team will try its hardest for you. Most juniors will have the chance to share a room with a student from another country. This gives you the chance to speak more English. While you are here, our team will talk to you to ensure you are settling in and happy with the accommodation. We regularly inspect our host accommodation and it meets British Council standards. Hosts live 10-30 minutes' walk from the junior centre or hosts will drive in and out each day.

Many of our young learners are away from home for the first time so we understand that some students will experience new emotions such as homesickness. This is why we have a full time dedicated team for our younger learners, to support and guide where needed. Fees Include

- Carefully inspected accommodation - shared bedrooms.
- Students walk or are driven for a maximum of 30 minutes.
- Care and support from the Welfare Officer.
- 24-hour emergency phone line with access to Welfare Officer.
- Level testing online before arrival to maximise learning time.
- 21 hours of lessons per week, OPTIONAL homework club and progress tests.
- A weekly half day excursion to towns and cities around Bury St Edmunds, for example Ipswich, Cambridge and Newmarket (integrated into syllabus).
- Saturday full day excursions with BLS activity staff and teachers to cities including London, Cambridge and Norwich (integrated into syllabus).
- 2 evening activities per week / 5 evenings with residential option.
- 1 afternoon per week of zumba, escape rooms, baking, sports, drama, martial arts.
- Three meals per day (packed lunches Mon to Sat).
- Course certificate.
- Wi-fi zones available in school and most homes.
- University of Cambridge FCE or IELTS Syllabus option.

Transfers

BLS arranges an individual / group meet and greet services on arrival and departure.

Assisted Check-In is compulsory for all under 16s. Cost £60 extra.

Cambridge and IELTS examination costs extra.

Registration procedure

- Pay non-refundable deposit of £175
- Receive preliminary confirmation letter
- Pay balance no later than 4 weeks before course starts
- Receive final confirmation and host details two weeks before arrival
