

### **Program Overview**

The IH Vancouver Pathway Program is designed to give you the language and cultural skills needed to succeed in North American universities or colleges.

When you enter the Pathway Program, and meet the required English level, you will study in the English for Academic Purposes (EAP) Course. (Followed by an IELTS Preparation course if required.)

When you successfully complete the program, you will finish with the ability to write, speak and listen at a level acceptable for academic studies in Canada.

### English for Academic Purposes consists of two levels

EAP1

12 weeks/20 EAP lessons + 10 elective lessons per week

Students will finish with an IELTS 5.5 or higher

EAP2

12 weeks/20 EAP lessons + 10 elective lessons per week

Students will finish with an IELTS 6.5 or higher



#### Student House

IH Vancouver maintains two student houses.

#### Student house points:

- Available to students over 19 years of age.
- Offers independent living by sharing an entire house with other students.
- Both private and shared rooms are available.

- Bed linens are provided but students should bring their own towel.

### Homestay

Our homestays are carefully selected and located in safe and pleasant residential neighbourhoods. Homestay accommodation gives students the chance to participate in some of the family life, experience a different culture and most of all, practice their English skills at home.

It typically takes between 20 to 50 minutes to get to and from the school by public transit.

# Teacher Training Programs

International House was the first organization to create a training course specifically for English as a Foreign Language teachers. The first International House Certificate in 1962 formed the basis for the current Cambridge CELTA qualification. 

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
