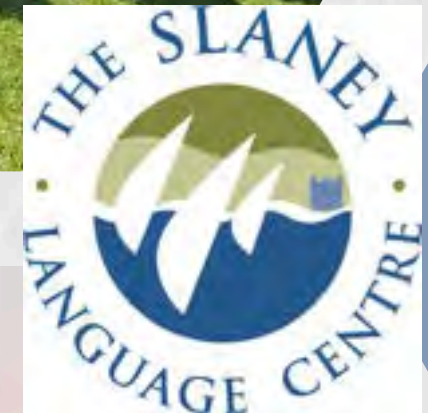

The Slaney Language centre has **over 25 years' experience** providing quality English Language Courses to groups and individuals of all ages from many different countries.

Our Ministay Programme takes place from September to Mid-June.

Programmes are **tailor made** to cater for groups of secondary school students, primary school students or adults.

Ministay Programmes are usually **full packages** including English Language Lessons, a Programme of Extracurricular Activities/Excursions, Host Family Accommodation and Airport transfers.

Most Ministay groups stay for 6 to 7 nights. We also cater for two or three week stays.

Arrival and departure days must be Saturdays or Sundays.

5-night stays from Monday to Friday available on request.



LANGUAGE LESSONS

Lessons may be held in the afternoons or occasionally in the mornings, depending on availability of classrooms.
Typically lessons take place from 14.00 to 17.15 with a short student break from 15.30 to 15.45.

Lessons may include Debates, Irish Culture Projects, Street Lessons, Quizzes, Songs...
They may also be specialised towards Exam Preparation, Sustainability/Environment, Teacher Training, Business English, CV Preparation, Job Interviews...

We tailor our Ministay programmes to the needs and requirements of each group.
Our Academic Director designs the lesson contents in co-operation with the Group's Representative.



POPULAR ACTIVITIES



MORNING

- Irish History: Treasure hunt and panoramic town walk
- Irish Culture: Make Saint Brigid Crosses
- Irish Nature: Beach Walks
- Irish Sports: Hurling, Gaelic Football, Crab Fishing
- Other Sports: Soccer, Footgolf.

* Irish dancing workshops, Breakdance workshops, Drumming workshops, Kayaking, Surfing or boat trips may be added to the programme of higher **budget** groups.

AFTER DINNER

Some groups add after-dinner activities, e.g.:

- Pool and Darts
- Picnic on the beach
- Bowling
- Farewell Party

DAYTRIPS

- Hook Peninsula, Tintern Abbey and Dollar Bay beach.
- Dunmore East and Waterford (Copper Coast)



AIRPORT TRANSFER OPTIONS

- Private Bus Transfer (recommended for large groups).
(If the group arrives early, we can include a few hours in Dublin City).
- Direct public bus (recommended for small groups).

ACCOMMODATION

Our ministay students usually stay with host families during their time in Wexford. This is a great opportunity for students to experience Ireland's renowned hospitality and the Irish way of life.

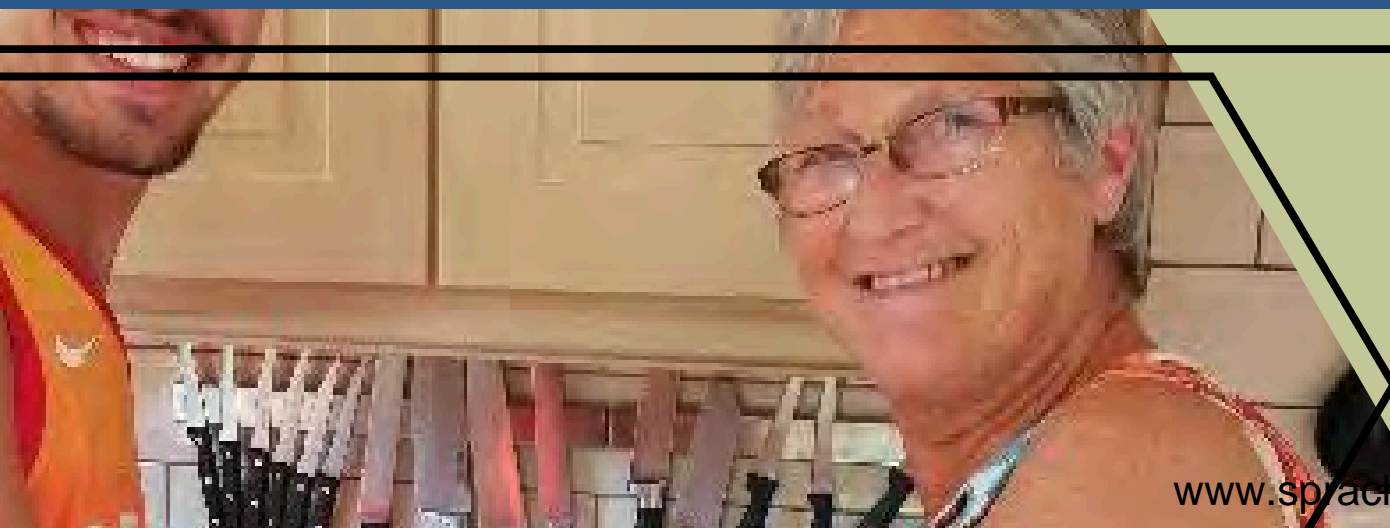
Host Family Accommodation includes breakfasts, packed lunches and evening meals
