Our ESL Wilderness Ranch is a unique school attached to a horse ranch with over 40 horses. Students have the opportunity to learn about horses and ride "Western" style while they continue to improve their language skills – at no extra cost! It is this continuity, speaking and listening to English 24/7 in a 100% immersion environment that really improves their language ability. At our school we offer 15 hours of classroom study per week / Studying in a beautiful and natural setting / A wilderness lifestyle experience / Active participation on a horse ranch.

Your Homestay is on site on the Ranch

Accommodation and meals are all included in the tuition fee. Stay on a real horse ranch! No commuting, no city noise. It is important that you have a place where you can feel at home so that your experience is unforgettable and enjoyable from start to finish. The ranch offers a safe, and beautiful environment in which to stay and study. By staying on the Ranch you have the advantage of being able to mix with the other students and staff and not be isolated in a strange home.

Weekend Adventure Opportunities

Weekends are a break from the classroom, when students get a chance to get involved in ranch activities and work with the horses. Optional activities like Grizzly viewing, fishing, visiting a ghost town or to go to the museum are available. Students can also try Extra riding lessons / A Mountain Day Ride / Horseback competitions / Archery and Target shooting or Wildlife viewing. Extra fees may apply.

After completing your ESL training, continue the process with your choice of our many wilderness schools. We train hike guides, horse guides and fishing guides. If you prefer the indoors, our Lodge Management Program will train you in cooking, housekeeping, office work, marketing and sales and ranch operations. Whether your interests are indoors or out, you will walk away with a solid base of combined working knowledge and practical skills.

Employment Opportunities at the Ranch

Apply your new knowledge and practical skills by working on our Ranch through our Paid positions, Practicum, Internship and Volunteer work programs. We have various jobs such as working in the kitchen, housekeeping, ranch hand, horse guide, office, sales and accounting.
