

Interning post-Brexit

Brexit may have changed a lot of things, but luckily, you can still do a professional work experience in the UK. The process to get to your internship is just a little different. There are however, various visas that will give you access to the London Internship programme.

These include:

- Student Visa (Formerly Tier 4 visa for University Students) If you are studying in the UK as a university student, you can do summer internships with Twin because of the work rights you receive under the Student Visa. This visa allows you to work up to 20 hours per week during term time, or complete a full-time internship outside of term dates.
- Tier 5 GAE Ecorys (Erasmus+) Visa If you are funded under the Erasmus+ project, you are still able to do an internship in the UK. Ecorys is the UK National Agency for Erasmus+ and they can sponsor candidates using their Tier 5 sponsorship service at no cost to you the applicant

Tier 5 Youth Mobility Scheme (YMS) visa. This visa is available to the following nations:

- Hong Kong
- Japan
- South Korea
- Taiwan

Tier 5 GAE Bunac Visa. This visa is available to students that meet the following criteria:

- Any nationality with a valid passport
- 18 years+
- Be a full-time degree level student or have graduated within the last 24 months at the start of your internship
- Have an IELTS score 6.0 or above
- Be able to show a minimum proof of funds of £1270 (UK immigration requirement)

English & Volunteering Programme

From 1-18 weeks

The new "Standard Visitor visa" (replacing the former Short term Study visa) gives all nationalities travelling to the UK the right to attend a volunteering experience in a registered charity for up to 30 days (six weeks). So, even in a post-Brexit UK, we still have great opportunities for you to improve your English language skills in a professional environment.

Twin will provide students with a letter of invitation to study that allows EU Nationals entry to the UK upon arrival. Non-EU students can use this letter in support of their visa applications.

It is important to note that while students with a Visit visa can volunteer, they cannot do 'voluntary work' for English language students to improve their language skills and help local communities.

Why Volunteering

We have put together two well-rounded programmes that meet the current visa regulations. They combine Volunteering Experience with English lessons so you can learn English and practice your new skills in a professional setting.

Boost your career prospects

Volunteering can have many benefits for your future career options, which make it well worth considering. It is a great way to gain practical experience and improve your CV, making you more attractive to future employers. By combining English courses with volunteering, you can make new friends and build your confidence. You will also increase your communication, customer service, teamwork and problem-solving skills.



All students holding a Visit visa can volunteer within a registered charity or voluntary sector organisation. It is a great opportunity if you want to improve your employability skills, meet local people, practice your English skills and develop new professional skills and knowledge.

Your placement will be an entry-living position in admin, hospitality or retail.
