

All tuition takes place in a relaxed and supportive classroom environment.

Small classes with a maximum of 8 students for general and examination classes (10 in summer) and maximum 6 for business classes (8 in summer) will give you every opportunity to practise and improve your communication skills in English.

We believe that learning is a partnership between learner and teacher, and all students are expected to play an active role in this process.

General English Courses

Classes at levels from elementary to advanced run all year. Beginners can only be accepted on specific dates (see Course Dates and Fees for information).

Morning classes include essential grammar work and oral practice, and work to improve your listening and reading skills. Consolidation work is offered every day for homework. Afternoon classes for Intensive courses focus on activating your English with speaking activities, vocabulary development and pronunciation. Intensive course students can also choose from a range of HELC Options for 2 lessons per week (see Course Dates and Fees for information).

General English Intensive - our most popular course

Lessons every morning and on four afternoons per week, making a total of $23^{1/4}$ hours (including Options lessons). Cambridge Examination English students follow the same timetable.

General English Standard – for part-time study & for beginners

Lessons every morning, 15 hours of classroom tuition per week.

Academic Year Programme – special price course for long stay students


A discounted programme for students who want to spend six months or more in England and take an examination. You will follow a General English Intensive course and/or a Cambridge Examination English course.

Personal Learning Programmes – General English plus Personal Tuition

15 hours of General English in the mornings with $4\frac{1}{2}$, 9 or 15 hours of personal tuition (one-to-one) in the afternoon. The personal tuition lessons focus on individual general English study needs.

Cambridge Examination English – the world's most popular English language examinations

Very small classes of between 5 and 8 students for those who need the language and skills necessary to pass Cambridge FCE and IELTS examinations.





Business English Courses

Professional English - targets the language of the business world

For people who require English for their work. The morning Professional English programme forms the foundation of all our work-related training courses and targets the key communicative grammar and language skills needed to use English confidently and successfully at work. All Executive English and Business English combination course clients join Professional English in the morning. Those requiring an all day businessoriented course should choose Business English or Executive English (see below for details). Alternatively you can join one of our General English afternoon classes.

Business English - targets essential business language and skills

For people who require a deeper understanding of English for business and who need to employ essential business skills such as presentations, meetings, negotiations and telephoning. Participants join the morning Professional English class, and in the afternoon have 81/4 hours of lessons dedicated to introducing and practising the core business skills.

Executive English - targets individual training needs through personal tuition

For people who already have experience of the business world and require more specific English training for their day-to-day working lives. Participants join the morning Professional English class. In the afternoon, Executive English participants choose 41/2, 9 or 15 hours of personal tuition. Alternatively participants can further accelerate their learning by choosing either 24 or 30 hours of personal tuition per week to concentrate solely on individual language and training needs.
