English & Culture: Experience London

This course is for you if you want to:

- Explore London's vibrant culture
- Work with students of a similar age (min age 50)
- Discuss topics of interest to more mature students

During the course, you will:

- Focus on functional English
- Develop your reading and listening skills
- Work on expressing yourself clearly
- Learn about British culture and history
- Study vocabulary related to cultural issues
- Improve your pronunciation and fluency

Topics may include:

- Social English
- Eating out
- Asking for and giving information
- British literature, music, and customs
- History of London
- Gardens and garden history

Excursion programme:

During the course, you will have 3 half-day excursions each week with your teacher; these will be decided in collaboration with your teacher and fellow course participants. Typical excursions include:

- British palaces and castles, e.g. Hampton Court Palace, Windsor Castle, Kenwood.
- Gardens, e.g. Kew Gardens, Richmond Park's Isabella Plantation, The Kyoto Garden
- Museums, e.g. The British Museum, the Museum of London, Sir John Soane's Museum
- Galleries, e.g. The Courtauld Institute, the National Portrait Gallery, Tate Modern

You will also:

- Go on a full day excursion on the Saturday after your first week
- Receive guidance and advice on your own self-study, including daily tasks
- Study 21st Century skills to reflect life in an international world
