





Our Optional Academies are for students who want extra training, in 1-to-1, 2-to-1 or small group lessons with dedicated coaches, so that they can improve their skills in Tennis, Golf or Horse Riding.

The safety and well-being of our students is central to everything we do at English Study Camps by Wimbledon School of English.

We ensure student welfare with:

- Caring and dedicated staff
- A designated Welfare Manager and Welfare Leaders at each centre
- First aiders at each centre and on excursions
- An average ratio of 1:8 staff to students on excursions ensures our students are well looked after
- Dedicated accommodation staff who liaise with students and hosts to ensure students are happy and comfortable in their homestay accommodation
- · House Parents and residential staff in every residence
- Level 3 safeguarding training for all our senior managers
- DBS checks for all our staff and host families
- First aiders on site at the residential centres and links with local doctors' surgeries and hospitals

Homestay Meals

Students staying in Homestay accommodation have their meals provided by their host family.

All students receive:

- Breakfast, packed lunch, and dinner
- The option to buy extra refreshments and snacks at an on-site Tuck Shop

We can accommodate halal, coeliac/gluten free, dairy free/lactose intolerant and vegan diets but there is a supplementary fee.

Residential Meals

Each residence has a use of a well-equipped canteen



Accommodation

We understand how important it is to feel at home in your accommodation. In London, we offer both Homestay and Residential accommodation. Our WSE homestays are welcoming and friendly, with many providers having worked with us for years. Homestay hosts can vary greatly, but they all share two key qualities: a genuine desire to welcome people into their homes and lives, and a clean, comfortable home.

Our residential accommodation, located at Surbiton Halls, offers students the experience of living in university halls. Students will have single en-suite rooms and will share a flat comprising six bedrooms. Our WSE staff will be on-site to supervise and support the students.


