Virtual Reality

Our school is one of the first which has implemented Virtual Reality in our teaching method. By using VR in class students can practice their speaking, listening and vocabulary skills with their classmates whilst being fully engaged in a virtual world. VR helps bring our books to life and encourages students to participate and work as a team.





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Adult Group Courses

Standard Group

General English Standard (20 lessons/max. 12 students)

Our General English Standard course focuses on giving the learner balanced practice in both systems (grammar, vocabulary, phonology, discourse) and skills using general topics and authentic material. The course concentrates on all the four skills: speaking, listening, reading, and writing with special emphasis on fluency. The aim of these English language courses is to improve the students' skills in all the areas of the language. This course is available in Malta and Gozo with a maximum of 12 students per class.

General English Intensive (30 lessons/max. 12 students)

The General English Intensive course includes the Standard English course and 10 extra lessons per week. The additional 10 lessons are held in the afternoons and focus on fluency, dedicating plenty of time to confidence-building, speaking practice, error correction and feedback. This course is ideal for learners who would like an opportunity to boost their speaking skills while interacting with other multinational students. Fluency lessons go beyond the book, helping students to speak English with ease and do any imaginable thing in an Englishspeaking country. The lessons include a variety of topics that cover functional language, everyday topics, role-plays, discussions, and social situations.



Mini Group

General English Mini (20-30 lessons/max. 6 students)

Mini-group courses have a maximum of 6 students per class, therefore guaranteeing more individual attention from the teacher and the ability to learn at a slower pace. Each of the group courses at our English language schools can be taken as a minigroup course; both our General English Standard courses and General English Intensive courses. The limited number of students per classroom benefits learners as it is allows each student more speaking time. Lessons can also be personalised more to address individual requests. Moreover, a small classroom environment gives the teacher more opportunities to observe and assess the students and their individual learning needs.

This course is ideal for teachers who would like an opportunity to fine-tune their teaching skills and apply new techniques and methods to their own classrooms. The lessons include a variety of topics that cover the essential skills to teach English along with other

subjects through functional language, role-plays, discussions and a variety of techniques to ensure that the students are absorbing as much of the language as possible.

Long-Term Programmes

Assessment & Progress of Learning

Our long-term programmes are ideal for students who want to experience living and studying in an English-speaking country. Taking a longterm course allows students to get a better understanding of the English language, work on weaknesses and improve at a steady pace. On Fridays, students get the possibility to do an end of unit test to monitor their progress in the week. The test covers grammar, vocabulary and listening skills and afterwards a class correction is done.

When a student feels that they are ready to progress to the next level, they can take the change of level test. Feedback is given on the students' strengths and weaknesses and if a student doesn't pass, study suggestions are given. At the end of their course students will receive a certificate of attendance and a personal note from the teacher about the student's progress throughout their stay.

Superior Residence

Staying in the BELS Residence adds to the immersive English-learning experience. It's an opportunity to meet new people, discover Gozo with fellow students and speak English outside of the classroom environment.

Our BELS Gozo Superior Residence is located on a quiet road in Victoria, the capital. The school is a 30-minute walk or a 10-minute bus ride away.

The BELS Superior Residence consists of three comfortably furnished apartments with four spacious bedrooms. All the apartments are comfortably furnished and with town views from the main terrace.

In each unit you can find Wi-Fi in all areas, communal bathrooms, a fully equipped kitchen, a washing machine and air-conditioned bedrooms. Bed linen and towels are supplied and replaced once a week as part of the cleaning service provided.

There are two possibilities to select from:

Superior Basic

These rooms can be booked as twin rooms (shared with another BELS student) or as single rooms (for students travelling on their own). Each bedroom has two twin beds, bed linen, a shared wardrobe, air conditioning, and heating. Rooms in this category do not have the option of a private bathroom.

Superior Plus with Ensuite Bathroom

The Superior Plus Rooms have the same amenities as the basic rooms but are more spacious and have an en-suite bathroom as well as a desk, a chair and a strong internet connection. These rooms are ideal for students who want to work remotely or need a private study environment. Rooms in this category may be reserved as single rooms for individual travellers or as a twin room for two individuals travelling together. Sharing room option is not available in this category. On my first day I was very very nervous but my lovely flatmates took me to school even though I had to be there one hour before them"

Homestay

Our host-families are hand-picked to ensure they share our values and passion. Additionally, they are fully licensed and undergo regular inspections.

Students will have their own key and can come and go as they please; while being respectful of their hosts.

In this category, students have the option to book a single room or share a room if they're travelling with a friend. Private bathrooms are possible at an extra supplement.

Accommodation in Malta

Residence Accommodation

In Malta, we offer 2 types of Residences: Comfort & Superior.

Comfort Residence

Our BELS Malta Comfort Residences are available in two separate premises. Each building is identical in relation to quality, amenities and pricing.

Each apartment consists of 3 bedrooms that are comfortably furnished for long or short stays. Every unit consists of a living area with Wi-Fi in the living area, a common bathroom, a fully equipped kitchen & a washing machine. Bed linen & towels are included and replaced as part of our weekly cleaning.

One can opt for one of these two choices:

Comfort Basic

Our Comfort Basic Rooms are located in 3 apartments behind our school building. These apartments can be booked as twin rooms. This is our most economical option, with significant price discounts for long-term students. Minimum stay in this category is 8 weeks. Each room includes a fan, two twin beds and a shared wardrobe.

Comfort Plus

Our Comfort Plus Rooms can be booked as twin rooms or single rooms. These rooms are available for any length of stay. Rooms in this category include a fan, two twin beds and a shared wardrobe.



Superior Residence

Our BELS Malta Superior Apartments form part of a modern and gated housing in Xemxija, a coastal area in the town of St. Paul's Bay. From here, students can reach the school in a 20-minute walk or catch a bus from a stop right outside the residence, which takes them directly to our school.

The main difference between our comfort and superior residences, is the airconditioning in the bedrooms.

There are two alternatives to choose from:

Superior Basic

Our Superior Basic Rooms are available as twin rooms (shared with another BELS student) or as single rooms. Each room includes two twin beds, bed linen, a shared wardrobe & air conditioning. A private bathroom can also be requested at an additional fee, when booking a single room.

Superior Plus

Superior Plus Rooms can also be booked as twin rooms or single rooms. When compared to the superior basic rooms, the superior plus rooms are more spacious and have a desk, a chair & strong internet connection. These rooms are ideal for students seeking to work remotely. Superior plus rooms also have sea views from the living room.

Homestay

By choosing home stay accommodation, students expand their experience in Malta to include a cultural and uniquely Maltese aspect. As well as benefitting from out-of-class opportunities to speak English, students will also discover more about the local life & traditions.

In our homestay accommodation, students will be treated as though they are a member of the household. In respect to the family, students are expected to adapt to the family's life and routine. Many of our home stays are within the area of the school, either a short walk or bus ride away. Breakfast and dinner are prepared by the host family. Our families cater for different allergies, special diets and preferences for a pet-free household.

Third-Country National students must purchase a travel insurance policy to cover their journey & stay in Malta & Gozo. They can acquire their own insurance or purchase one through BELS. The insurance needs to cover claims related to travel, health, injury, loss or damage of personal belongings & cancellations. The insurance policy is a requirement of the visa extension.

Classes

Classes are held from Monday to Friday. We reserve the right to introduce a double banking timetable & to use classrooms in alternative premises of the same standard.

Schools will be closed on public holidays. No lessons will be held on these days. There is no refund for group lessons missed due to a public holiday. Individual lessons will be made up.

Compulsory Extension of Visa Processing & Handling Fee

A charge of €60 applies to those students who will need a visa application or visa extension.

Course Material

Our courses are based on course material that cover the main skills needed for the students to improve. As learners improve during their stay with us, they are given the opportunity to



take a change of level test. If they pass the test they will need to purchase more material since when they are promoted to a higher level group.

On their first day, adult students will be given a course book based on their level, as achieved in the test. Students are informed not to write in the book until they are sure that it is the right level for them. If they write in the book and then request to change level, a second book will need to be purchased.







Booking of the Language Learning Holiday

Please use the BELS enrolment form to book your language holiday. Your booking with the school is binding as soon as you receive written confirmation. As a rule, you will receive confirmation of your booking within the next business day.

Classes

Note: In cases where there are from one to three students in a class, lessons will be reduced. The improved teacher attention and increased quality time will enable us to offer a more personalised course focused on 60 - 65% of the ordinary number of lessons. One may note that students will be receiving more teacher contact time, leading to better quality tuition at no extra cost.

Pre-Arrival Test

If the student does not complete the test three weeks prior to the start date, they run the risk of being placed in a class of a different level or group size, based on spacing and level availability.

Holidays

Holiday breaks for Academic Year Programme students (20 + weeks+): Students have 2 weeks holidays for every 12 weeks booked. They need to advise us of their holiday breaks, 2 weeks in advance. Students returning from their holiday should not expect to return to the same class, teacher, or accommodation. No credit will be given for accommodation during holiday breaks. Transfers





Illegal substances, cigarettes and alcohol are not permitted during the programme. Students who fail to comply with the programme rules will be sent home at their parents'/ guardians' expense. Students who arrive in Malta without the consent form signed by their parent/ guardian will not be allowed to participate in the BELS Juniors programme. When signing the consent form the parent/guardian also confirms that if the child does not comply with the programme rules, or with any other rules that may be set by the school from time to time, s/he will be expelled from the programme and be sent home at the guardian's expense. This means that the child will not be allowed to mix with our students, and hence change of accommodation will be requested until repatriation. BELS' responsibility towards the child will end twelve hours after an incident has been reported. No refunds will be given in the case of a student's expulsion.



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
